Street lights



Streetlights are vital to our everyday lives. Street lighting provides a number of important benefits. It can be used to promote security in urban areas, they also improve safety for drivers and pedestrians.

The Public Works Department conducts a quarterly assessment of streetlights in the city to help with any issues. Team Members will work an overnight shift driving every street and checking every light. If they come across a light malfunctioning they will be marked with a colored ribbon, logged and called in to the appropriate energy company. Team Members will follow-up to assure they have been fixed.

To report a street light issue, please contact (859) 727-7620, (859) 727 3893 or email info@erlangerpw.com. Please try to provide the following information: pole number/nearest address of light, type of issue, (out, flickering, burning during the day etc.) and your contact information.

Once reported Duke Energy or Owen Electric will schedule the repair.
