SIGN SHOP ACTIVITIES



- During the month Team Members installed 12 new signs utilizing 7 poles and 7 anchors.
- In the month of February Team Members performed a city wide street light check and found 28 street light in need of repair that were reported to their respective utilities company.
- Duke Energy is still in the process of installing the decorative street lights on the corner of Dixie Highway and Commonwealth Avenue.
- There was 10 new regulatory signs printed and sheeted along with 32 door decals and truck numbers for Public Works Fleet and 30 stickers for the Fire Department.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Narrows Road / Nelson Road Intersection Improvement Project will resume as weather permits. The asphalt walking paths that will connect to the Glades walking path will be installed in the spring, once plants are up and running for the season.
- The Alpha Ct., Beta Ct., Kelli Ln., and Michelle Cr. Project will resume this spring, updates will be posted as to when dates are determined.
- The Sidewalk Replacement Project is on hold for the time being due to winter weather, our contractor will resume in Zone 2 in the spring.
- The Atlas Dr. Brightleaf Blvd. (between Narrows Rd and Turkeyfoot Rd) and Center Street projects will begin this Spring as well.

TRAINING

- The Public Works Leadership Team participated with other department leaders in an Disaster Response Exercise on February 27th.
- The Public Works Leadership team also worked an exercise on Critical Response Plan. That will be covered with the entire Public Works Team.
- All Team Members participate and lead a daily safety briefing on a particular subject, February was Personal Protective Equipment. They talked about experiences and knowing when and when not to wear protective equipment.
