

PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT

LEAF COLLECTION

The 2021 Leaf Collection Program concluded on Friday 12/10/2021. Due to the heavy volume of leaves and a weather event that occurred in the second to last week of pick up, the PW's decided to send the crew out one more time for a sweep of the city on the next Monday and Tuesday to make sure all the leaves were picked up. The leaf crew did an exceptional job keeping on schedule and providing the residents with such a great service.





CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

The annual Christmas Tree recycling program will run from December 26th through January 12th, 2022. The trees will be mulched on the 12th by Kenton County PWs and will be disbursed among several county parks as bedding and for paths. The trees can be dropped off at the Erlanger PWs facility from 7am until 4pm M-F.

PROGRAMS

STREET SWEEPING

The final quarterly round of 2021 was completed and a team member used 42 man hours to sweep the entire city including the main corridors. These hours included minor maintenance issues and clean up at the end of each day.

CHOKE POINTS

The PW's department has choke points throughout the city that are checked for debris before a substantial rainfall to prevent flooding issues. PW's refer to these areas as the "Nasty Nine". The Nasty nine were checked twice this month.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

LEXINGTON DRIVE

The Lexington Drive project has been completed all residents back in their driveways before Christmas. Jefferson Contracting has worked tirelessly to make certain this project was completed on schedule.

WOODWARD AVE.

The Woodward Avenue project has ended for this construction season and will be completed in the Spring of 2022. All residents have access to their driveways and the roadway is completely open to traffic.

Zeta Court

Team Members have been working with the city engineer in the planning stage for Zeta Court. This project will go out to bid in February and start in the spring of 2022 with a completion date set for June 2022.

All classes have been completed for the year and the PW's department is awaiting the new training schedule to register for classes in 2022.
