Ladders Training

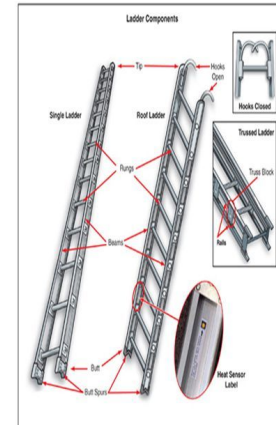
December 2 - 4 2019

- Truss block

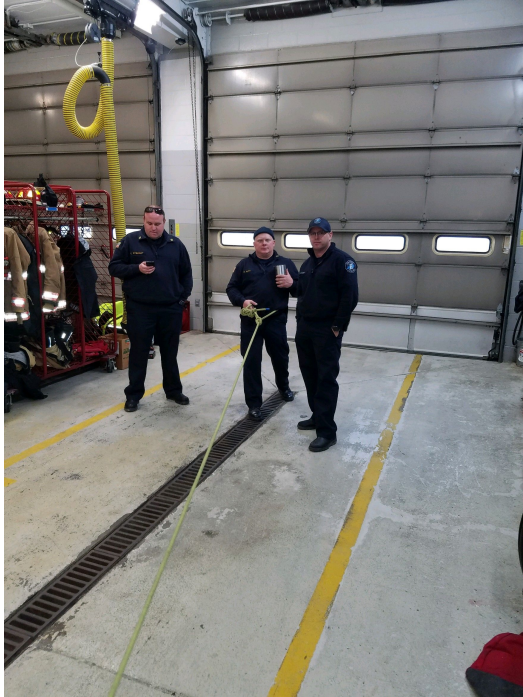


Training for the Month

Life Safety Inspections

The Department performs Life Safety Inspections for all public buildings in the City of Erlanger. During a Life Safety Inspection, Members meet with business representatives and check the buildings to ensure that all codes are met, proper inspections (fire alarm, sprinkler, hood suppression systems and boiler) are maintained, fire extinguishers are current, and general fire hazards are recognized. If discrepancies are located, a re-inspection can be performed after the corrections are made. The department is responsible for over 600 Annual inspections throughout the year, not including those involving new construction .

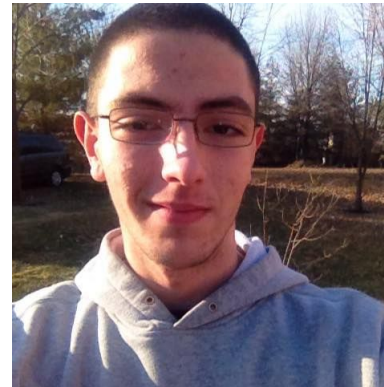
