Members then reviewed the ice rescue equipment carried on the apparatus.








#### **LEPC Orientation**

Our SWAT Medics (McMullen and McDonald) completed self defense and tactical operations training with the Kenton County SWAT Team.











#### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

February 11 - 12 - 13 2019

Personal Protective Equipment, or PPE, is fire gear utilized within the fire service. Each Shift reviewed the type of PPE Erlanger Fire/EMS uses, as well as its proper cleaning and maintenance. The International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) sets standards for proper donning of the gear, and in order for a firefighter to become certified, they must be able to dress in fire gear and breathing apparatus within 1 minute and 30 seconds.

#### Technical Rescue Team - Apparatus Review

February 12 2019

Members from our Department attended a technical rescue apparatus review. When the Technical Rescue Team (TRT) is dispatched, Members from participating Departments respond and bring various apparatus. Erlanger featured Rescue 74 which contains equipment for rope rescue, trench rescue, confined space rescue, search and collapse. Alexandria reviewed Heavy Rescue 120, and Point Pleasant displayed Rescue 1374. The training was hosted by the Alexandria Fire Department.











#### Paramedic Refresher

February 7 - 14 - 21 2019

Hebron Fire Protection District hosts a six-week training course that encompasses various instructors in the medical field, teaching paramedics different topics. These topics are necessary for recertification, and our On-Duty Crews are able to attend using the "Gotomeeting" application at our Stations.







#### **Child Abuse Awareness**

February 20 - 21 - 22 2019

The Family Nurturing Center provided Child Abuse and Neglect Training for all three Shifts. They reviewed the signs of abuse and how to properly report if encountered.



# Life Safety Inspections

The department performs Life Safety Inspections for all public buildings in the City of Erlanger. During a Life Safety Inspection, members meet with business representatives and check the buildings to ensure that all codes are met, proper inspections (fire alarm, sprinkler, hood suppression systems and boiler) are maintained, fire extinguishers are current and general fire hazards are recognized. If discrepancies are located, a re-inspection can be performed after the corrections are made. The department is responsible for over <u>600</u> inspections throughout the year.

We hosted Erlanger Police and their Citizens Police Academy for the class on traffic stops. Students learned what it is like to stop a car for a traffic violation.








