Just like the public, our Members must recertify in CPR. Our Department instructors held classes for our Members.

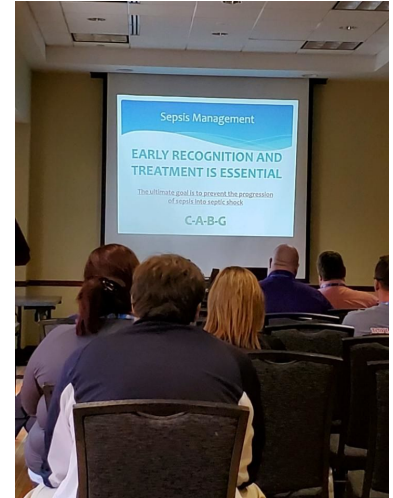


# Training for the Month

# Life Safety Inspections

The Department performs Life Safety Inspections for all public buildings in the City of Erlanger. During a Life Safety Inspection, members meet with business representatives and check the buildings to ensure that all codes are met, proper inspections (fire alarm, sprinkler, hood suppression systems and boiler) are maintained, fire extinguishers are current and general fire hazards are recognized. If discrepancies are located, a re-inspection can be performed after the corrections are made. The department is responsible for over **600** inspections throughout the year.

Engine 51 and Medic 64 attended a brunch sponsored by Erlanger United Methodist Church to honor our Veterans and First Responders.

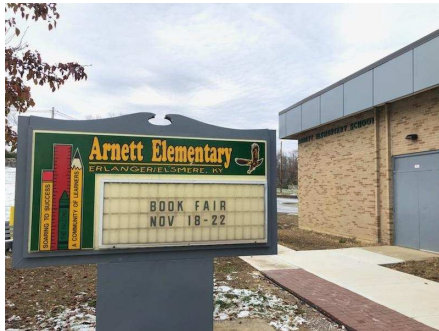
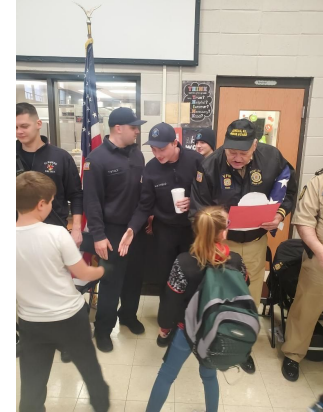

In total, our Department has performed 38 Car Seats Installations in 2019.



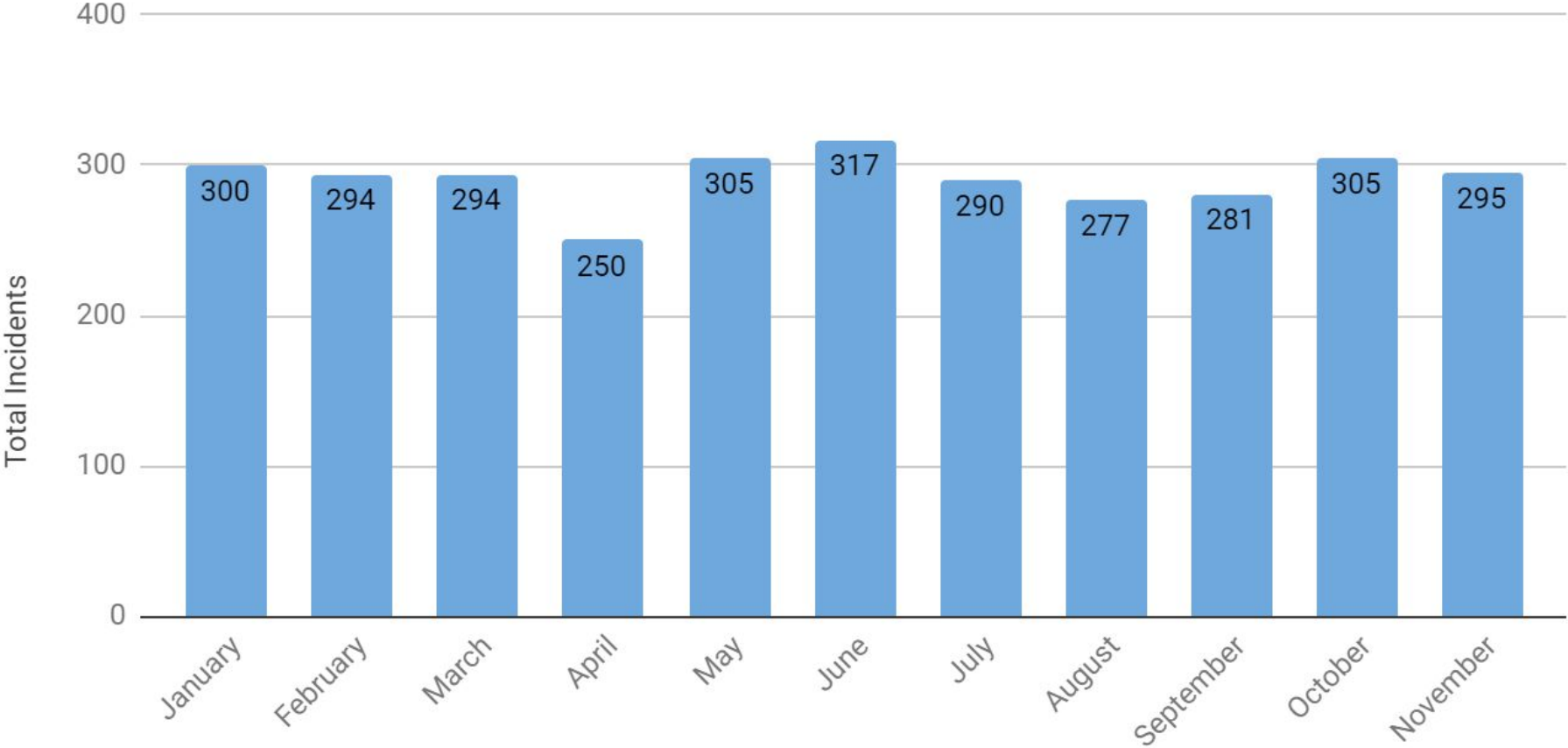
