Fire Attack and Hydrant Connections

September 3 - 5 2019

Members practiced pulling attack lines, connecting to fire hydrants and pumping the trucks. The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) created a training numbered 1410. This drill requires Members to perform several firefighting tasks at the same time.







Loss Control Training

September 9 - 11 2019

Members of all three Shifts practiced preserving property, aka loss control. Most people think of protecting property from a fire, and while that is an important part of loss control, we train to preserve property no matter the emergency. Businesses will call for broken sprinkler pipes, heavy rains cause basements to flood, and we respond to pump out the water. We have also responded for clogged toilets and backed up drains as well.





Fire Hose Advancement


September 18 - 20 2019

Crews practiced advancing charged fire hose through the firehouse. When the line is charged (filled with pressurized water), it becomes more difficult to navigate around corners and obstacles.











OSHA Training

September 23 - 25 2019

Members reviewed the OSHA - Bloodborne Pathogen procedures and the HAZCOM (Hazardous Communications) guidelines. With the amount of EMS calls we respond to, it is important to stay current on procedures to prevent infection.



Life Safety Inspections

The Department performs Life Safety Inspections for all public buildings in the City of Erlanger. During a Life Safety Inspection, members meet with business representatives and check the buildings to ensure that all codes are met, proper inspections (fire alarm, sprinkler, hood suppression systems and boiler) are maintained, fire extinguishers are current and general fire hazards are recognized. If discrepancies are located, a re-inspection can be performed after the corrections are made. The Department is responsible for over <u>550</u> inspections throughout the year.

September 14 2019


Lloyd Memorial High School - Homecoming Parade


