

ORDINANCE NO. 2493

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY,
CREATING A HUMANE RETIREMENT FOR THE NON-HUMAN K-9 UNITS**

WHEREAS, the City of Erlanger desires to create a humane retirement for its K-9 Animals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Erlanger desires to supply financial support for the receiving officer so the receiving officer only needs to worry about housing and caring for the retired animal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 Retirement of K-9 Animal and Establishment of Funds to Maintain the K-9 Unit

The K-9 Handler will have an opportunity to house and care for the retired K-9 animal. If the K-9 Handler is unwilling or unable to care for the retired K-9 animal, then the Erlanger Police Department shall, prior to retirement, find a suitable adoption service. The K-9 Supervisor shall oversee ensuring that the permanent placement of the K-9 is suitable shelter and care of the K-9 animal.

The Erlanger Police Department shall maintain a \$2,000 per fiscal year budget for retired K-9 animals' reasonable expenses, including, but not limited to - Food, Veterinary Care, Medications, and Proper Boarding while the K-9 Handler is out of town.

The K-9 Handler shall supply receipts to the Erlanger Chief of Police or his designate prior to reimbursement of any of the expenses within 30 days of incurring the expense.

Section 2.0

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect if they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).




