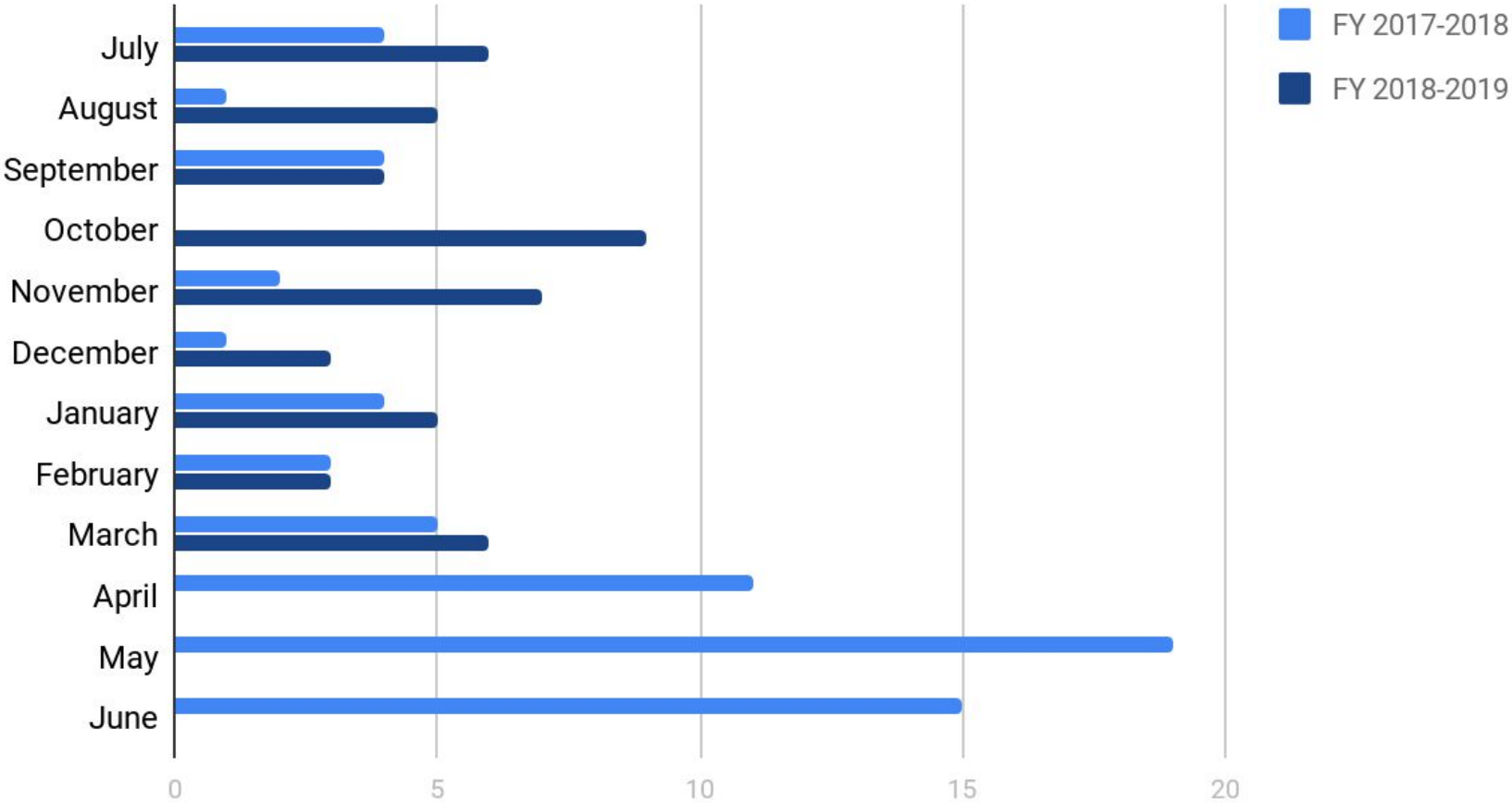

Important Reminders/News

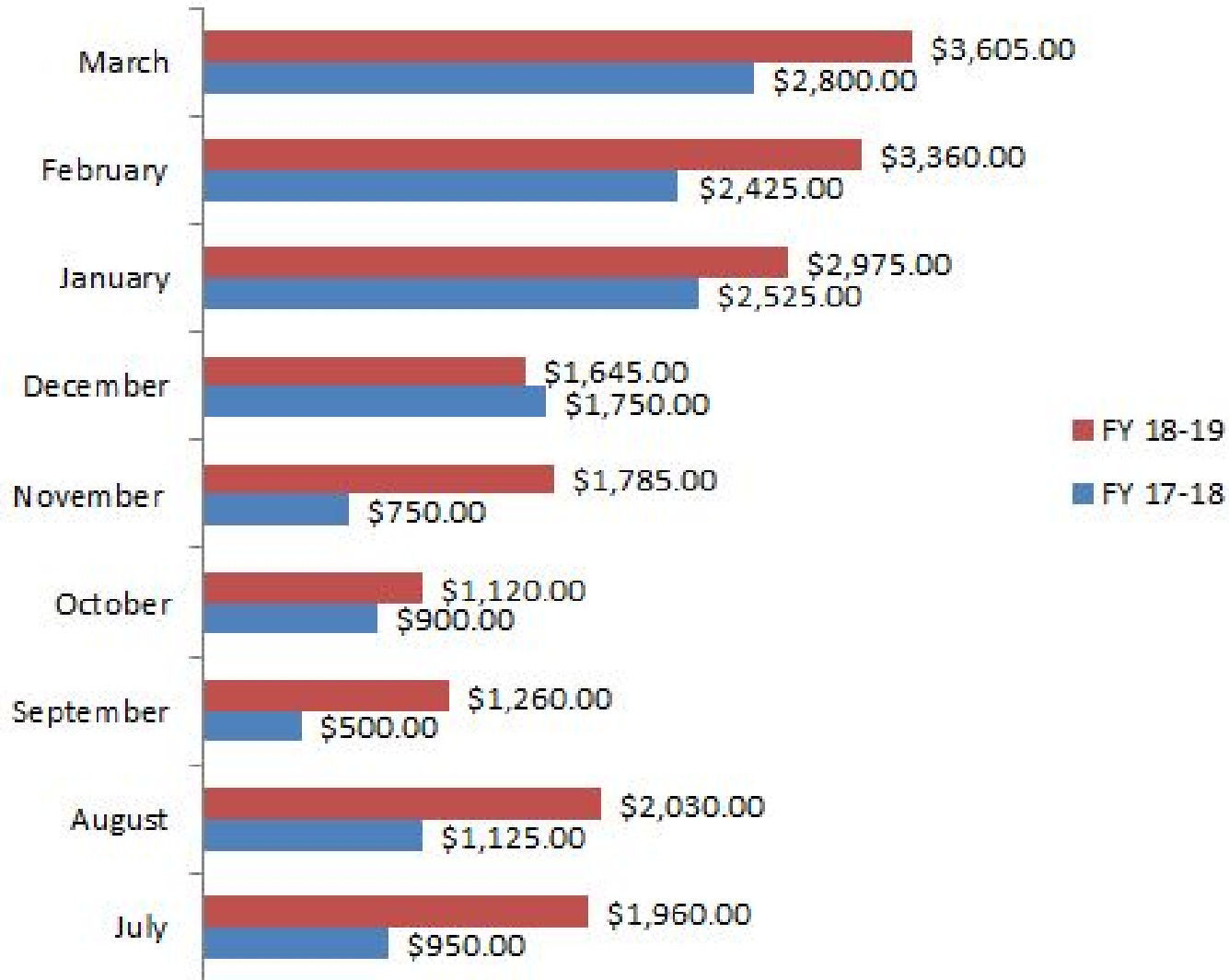
For those who have started their spring cleaning, Kenton County has scheduled their annual Spring Clean-Up event for May 2-4, 2019. More information will be provided as it is received.

Passport Fees Collected



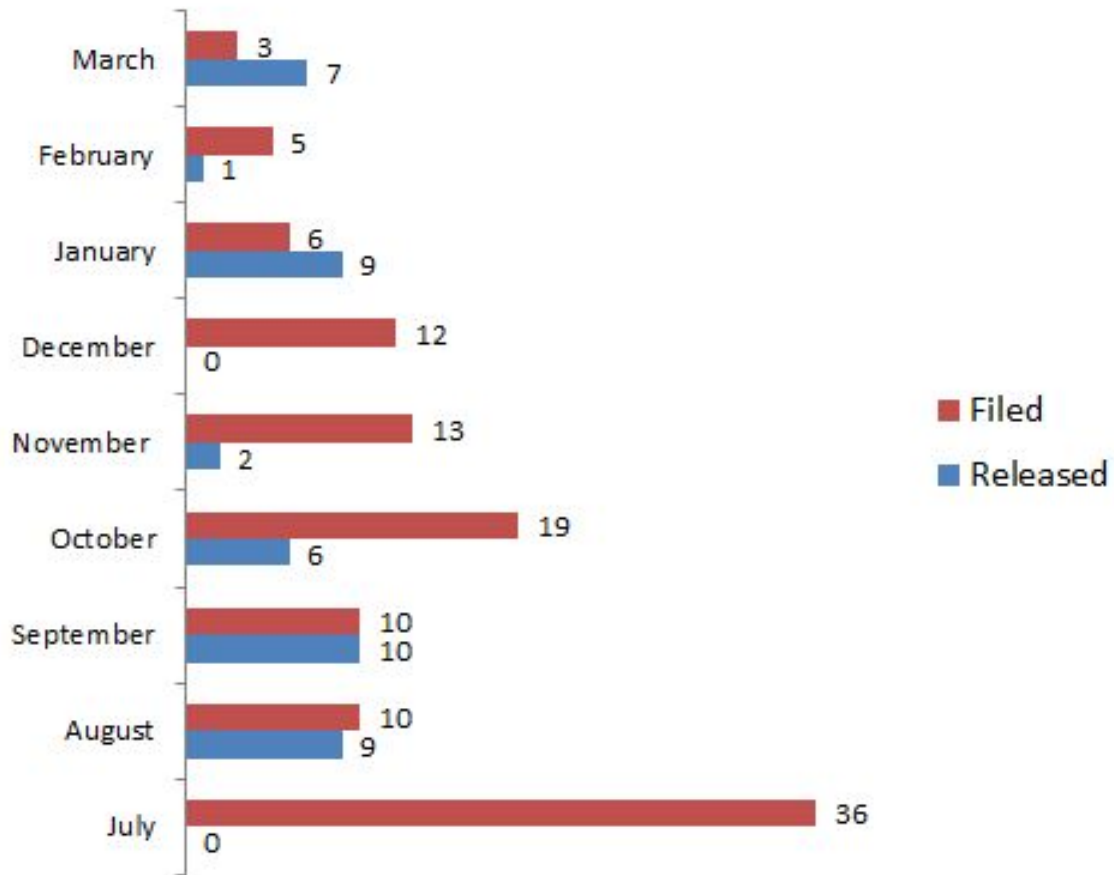
Property Tax Collection FY 18-19
