If you miss this event and are a Kenton County resident, you can apply to receive a free voucher from the Kenton County Public Works Department. The voucher allows you to take unwanted trash to the Bavarian Landfill located in Walton, Kentucky. Vouchers are distributed monthly. Please Note: Vouchers will not be distributed in April due to the Spring Clean-up event.

# RUMPKE FUEL SURCHARGE

## **Waste & Recycling Price Increase Effective April 1, 2022**

Due to the addition of a fuel surcharge, beginning April 1, 2022, the weekly trash collection rate for Erlanger residents is \$16.29 per month. The subscription curbside recycling rate is \$6.34 per month.

## **Understanding the Increase**

As part of the City of Erlanger's contract with Rumpke Waste & Recycling, Rumpke can assess a fluctuating fuel surcharge annually if diesel fuel rises above \$3 per gallon. The rate will increase or decrease on April 1 each year based on fuel prices the first week of March. The first week of March 2022, diesel fuel was \$4.649 per gallon, per the US Department of Energy's Diesel Prices Index. Therefore, the annual fuel surcharge effective April 1, 2022 is \$0.84. This amount will remain in effect until April 2, 2023 when the fuel prices have been reassessed.

## **Calculation of the Fuel Surcharge**

The fuel surcharge is related directly to the national diesel fuel prices as reported by the Energy Information Administration of the U.S. Department of Energy (EIA/DOE) in its Retail On-Highway Diesel Prices Index for the Midwest Region. This index is available to the public and is widely recognized in trucking and transportation industries.

As part of the City's contract with Rumpke, Rumpke established a range for fuel costs and an associated fuel surcharge amount. This information can be found at [erlangerky.gov](http://erlangerky.gov).

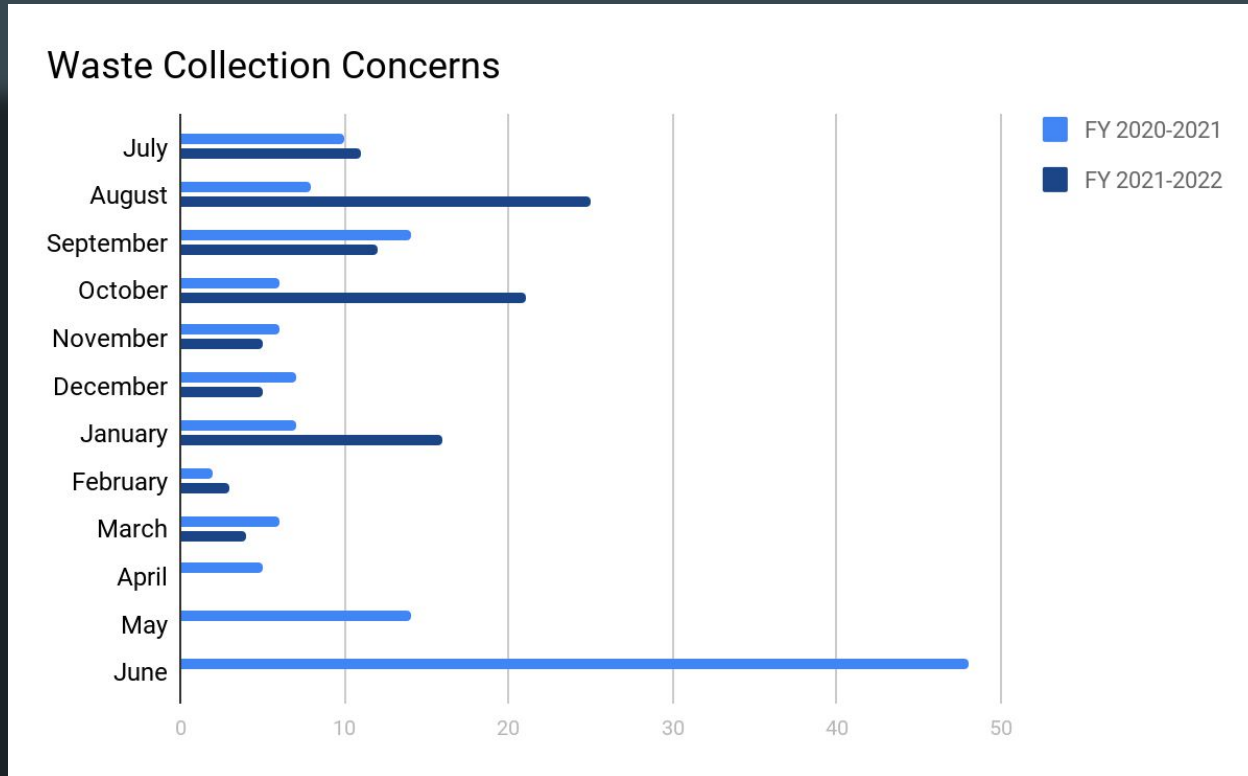

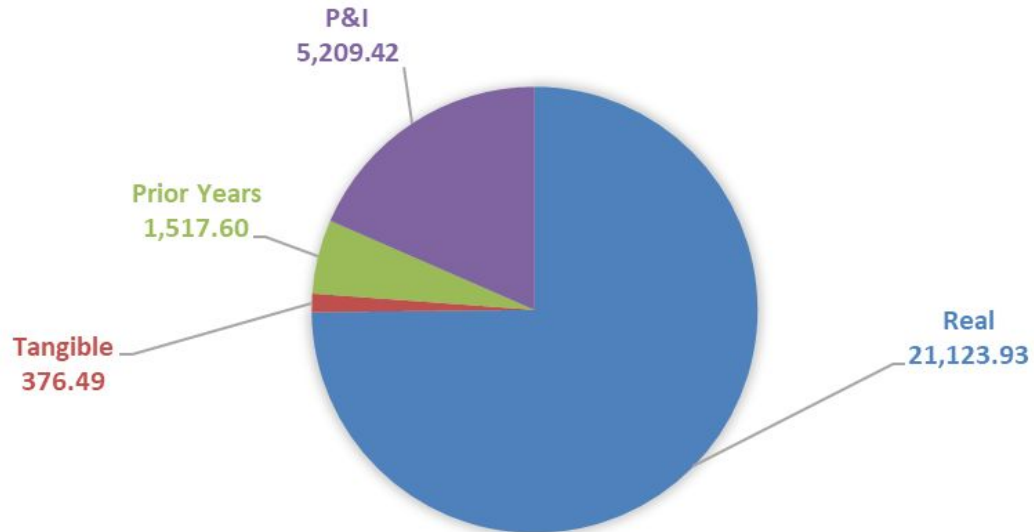

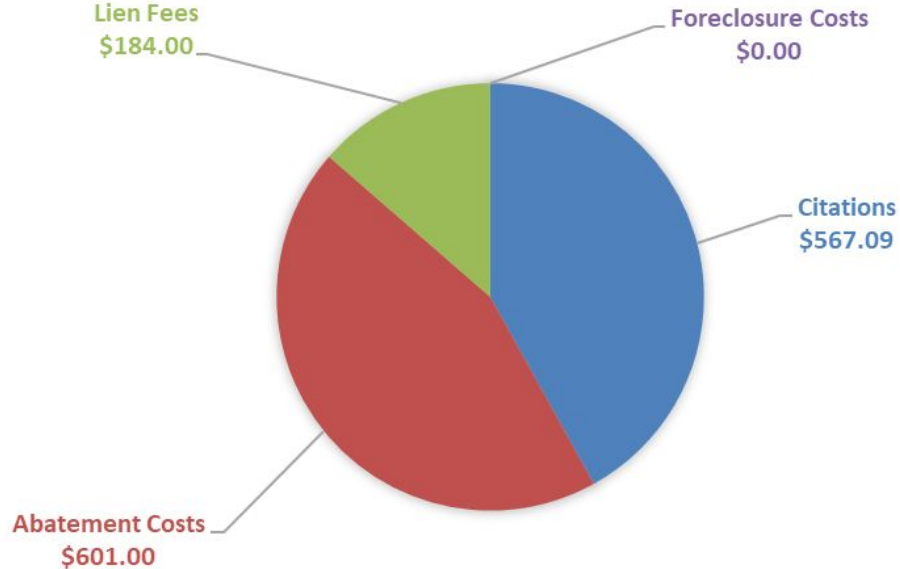

## MARCH PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION \$28,227.44



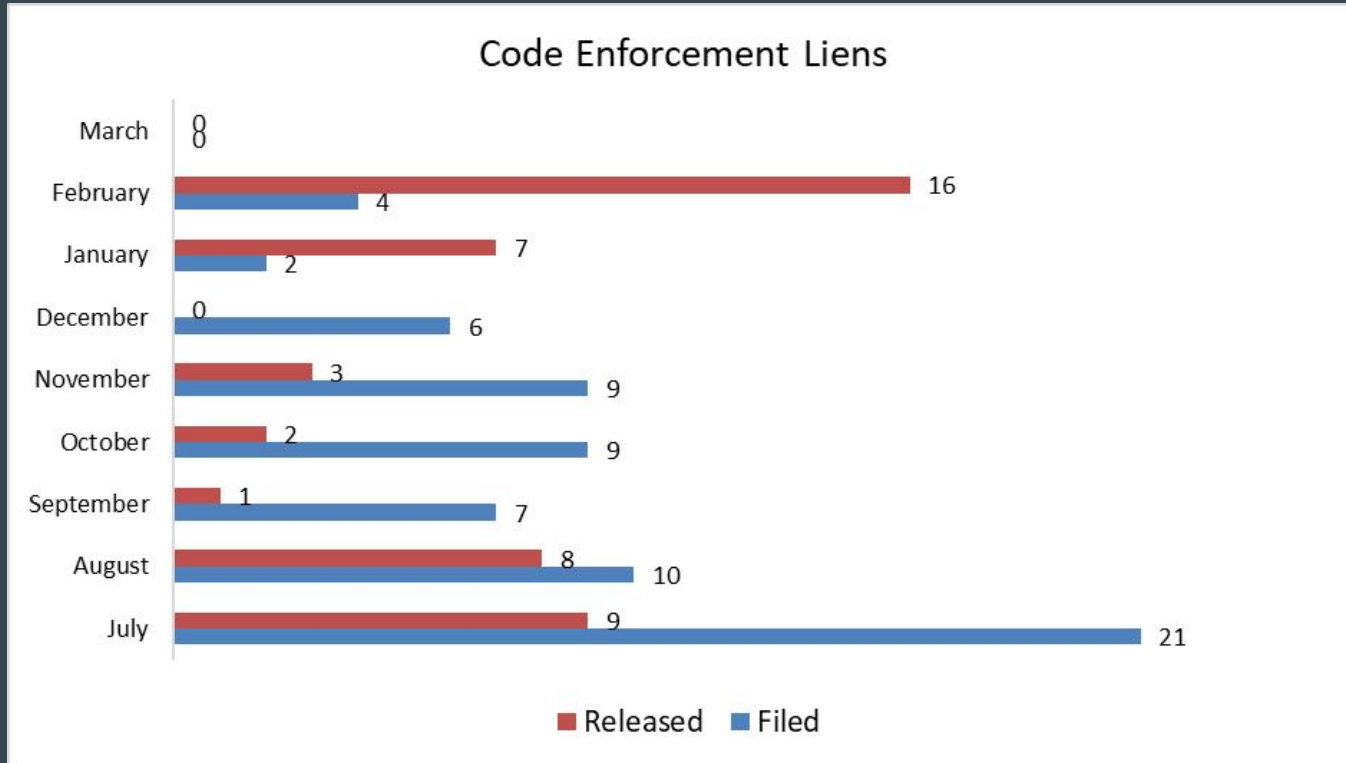
# CODE ENFORCEMENT FINES COLLECTED

## MARCH CODE ENFORCEMENT FINES COLLECTED \$1,352.09

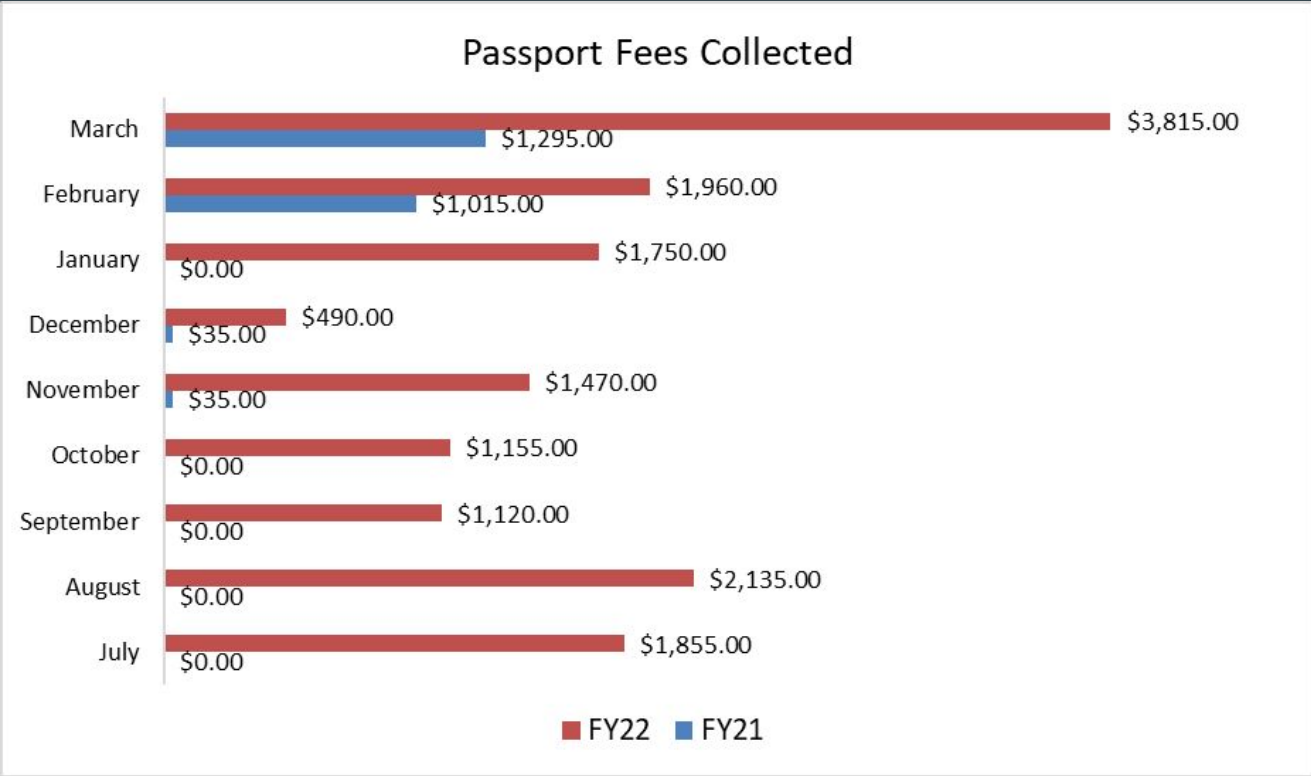




# CODE ENFORCEMENT LIENS

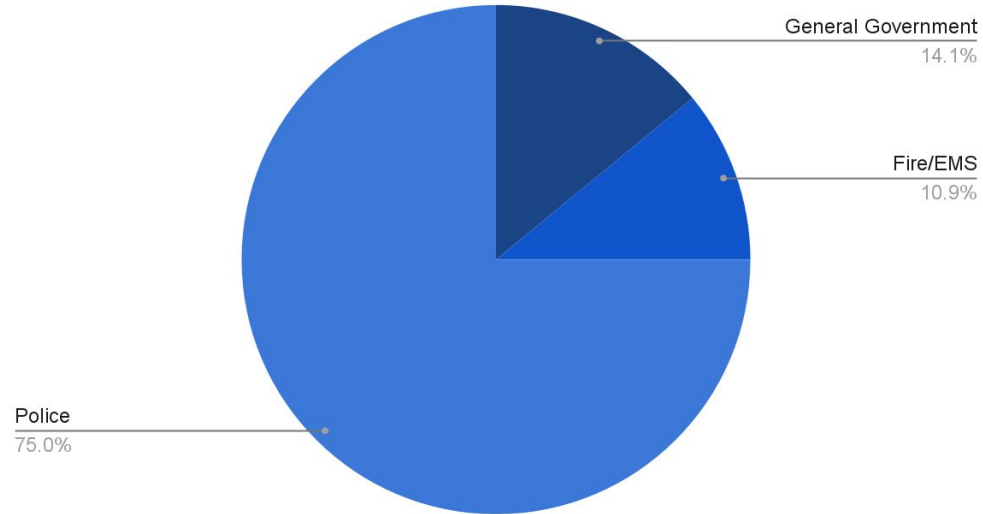


# PASSPORT FEES COLLECTED

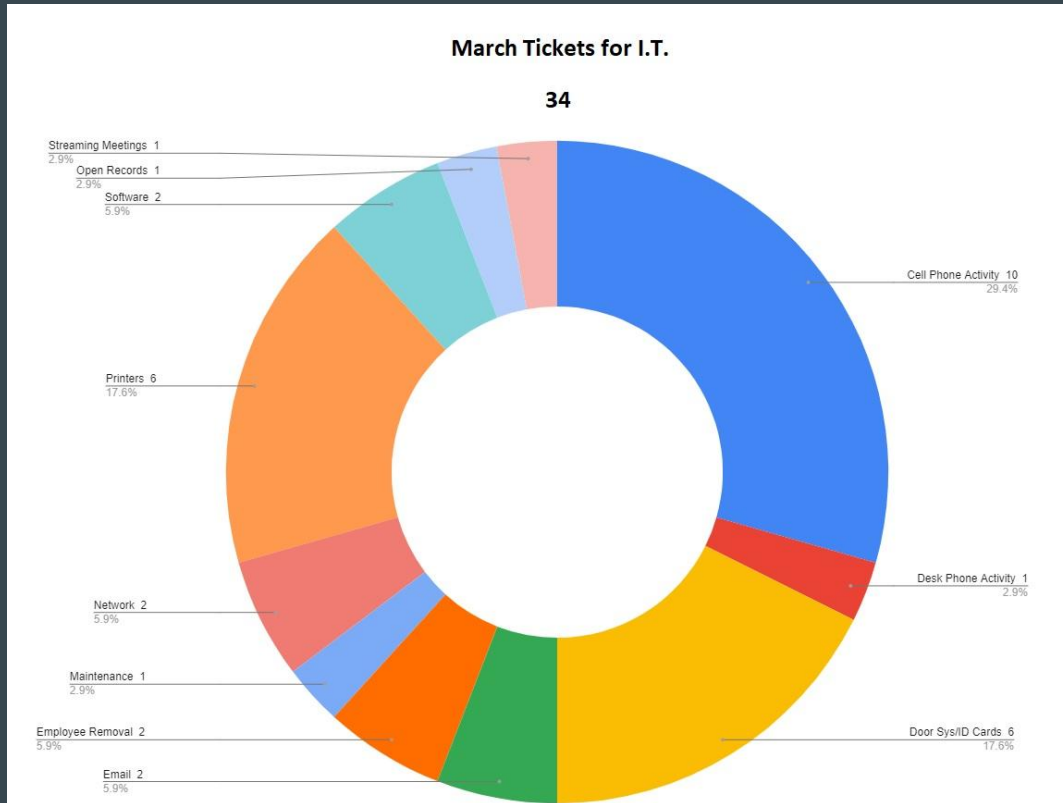
