PROGRAMS

Erlanger Salutes

The Erlanger Salutes Banner Program was created for the community to recognize and honor individuals on active duty, living, retired, and deceased service personnel by displaying the honoree's photo, name, rank and armed service branch on a banner to be flown from utility poles throughout the City of Erlanger. All banners are displayed with an American flag.

Banners will be displayed on Commonwealth Avenue, from Baker Street to Dixie Highway, and on Dixie Highway within Erlanger city limits. These banners will be displayed for up to 3 years and then returned to the sponsor.

Mowing

The PW's crews have 34 city owned properties that are mowed weekly. These properties range from facilities, parks to ROW's. The city also contracts out 13 other properties such as alleyways and other green spaces. PW's crews have worked **462** man hours in May keeping the City looking Exceptional.

Mulching

The PW's Department annually has all beds and tree rings mulched prior to Memorial Day. The department does a majority of the mulching in house and utilizes contractors to mulch six locations throughout the City. This year NK Lawn Pros received the bid for the contracted mulching. All mulching has been completed for this year.

TRAINING

Team members are again attending virtual and off site training classes. These classes are part of the Road Scholar / Road Master program hosted by the University of Kentucky Technology Transfer Center.

Upcoming Classes:

Basic Plan Reading

June 7th,
This workshop takes participants through the various types of plans used at road departments. They will discover how to read and interpret the different types of standard symbols and abbreviations. It will discuss features and details contained within plans: how to define the types of scales and identify dimensions found on plans.

Environmental Awareness

June 8th,
The concept of going about highway maintenance in a manner that is environmentally acceptable is of great importance to state and local agencies. This workshop explores how to perform our routine highway maintenance and achieve quality production while being environmentally responsible and compliant.

Roadside/Vegetation Management

June 15th,
This workshop covers the basics of managing all types of roadside vegetation. It discusses the importance of an Integrated Roadside Vegetation Program (IRVM) and how to achieve a well-balanced program.
