-We discussed the rollover amount from the previous year regarding the Silverlake restroom project being delayed due to backordering on materials, which will be discussed at the council meeting that evening. We discussed line iteming the parks budget and what that means. Kara suggested including a certain threshold (30-50%) in the budget for items that did not get completed in the previous fiscal year. This money would only be used for those rollover items.


