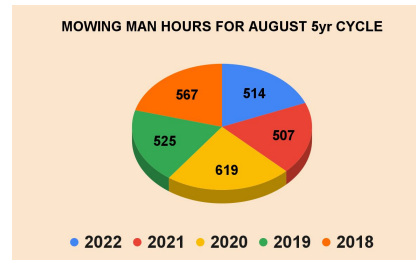
## PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT



### PROGRAMS

#### Mowing

The PW's crews have **34** city owned properties that are mowed weekly. These properties range from facilities, parks to ROW's. The city also contracts out **13** other properties such as alleyways and other green spaces. PW's crews worked **514** man hours in August keeping the City looking Exceptional.



#### Sign Replacement Program

The City established a program to comply with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) which regulates what a sign looks like, the size, the font and the way it is retroreflective (to be visible at night). They offer a few ways to do this and the City has chosen a blanket replacement program where all the signs get replaced at a certain interval which the City has decided that would be every **10** years (the average lifespan of a sign). The program consist of **8** phases. Earlier this year, phase **4** was completed which was all the signs that there are a limited number of compared to others, such as Yield and No Outlet signs. There were **175** signs switched out to new ones.

Phase **5** will start next and it is the switch out of all street IDs. PW's has the City divided into **4** zones, completing one zone a year which means the street IDs will take 4 years to replace all of them. PW's will start in zone 1 which has a total of **143** street IDs and continue the next 3 years until complete where a total of **512** street IDs will have been replaced.

### CAPITAL PROJECTS

#### Silverlake Park Restroom

The new Silverlake Park restroom project is nearing completion, Radius Construction is awaiting the delivery and installation of the pergola that will cover the picnic area between the restroom and swing area, this is scheduled to be completed in a couple weeks.

#### Silverlake Park Phase 2

The park project has been completed this week with the installation of the swings that the contractor had been waiting on missing pieces for.

#### Asphalt Paving Project

Michels Construction has been awarded the Jacqueline Drive, Kimberly Drive, Mitten Drive and Debbie Lane resurfacing and sidewalk project, this project should begin late September.

#### Concrete Street Reconstruction Project

Jefferson Contracting has been awarded the Sigma Drive, Kappa Court and Theta Court reconstruction project, this project will begin mid September.

#### Public Workshops

The Public Works Department has 2 Public Workshops scheduled for the asphalt paving and concrete street reconstruction projects. The concrete street reconstruction workshop is on August 31st and the asphalt paving workshop is on September 1st. Both workshops run from 4pm to 6 pm and will take place in the council chambers at the Erlanger City Building.

### TRAINING

Team members are again attending virtual and off site training classes. These classes are part of the Road Scholar / Road Master program hosted by the University of Kentucky Technology Transfer Center.

#### Small Bridge Repair and Maintenance

September 14th

This classroom-based workshop explains the basics of small bridge and culvert maintenance and inspection. It covers basic bridge types, components and mechanics as well as the current state of both the nation's and Kentucky's bridges. Bridge inspections requirements are also discussed in detail. Participants are given information on how to perform basic maintenance on bridges and how to obtain funding for bridge replacement when necessary.
