The General Government Departments will be closed on November 24th and 25th in observance of Thanksgiving.


WASTE COLLECTION

Rumpke WILL collect waste and recycling on Thanksgiving day. Please make sure that you have your tote(s) out the night before as they may begin their routes earlier.


HOLIDAY LIGHT RECYCLING PROGRAM






