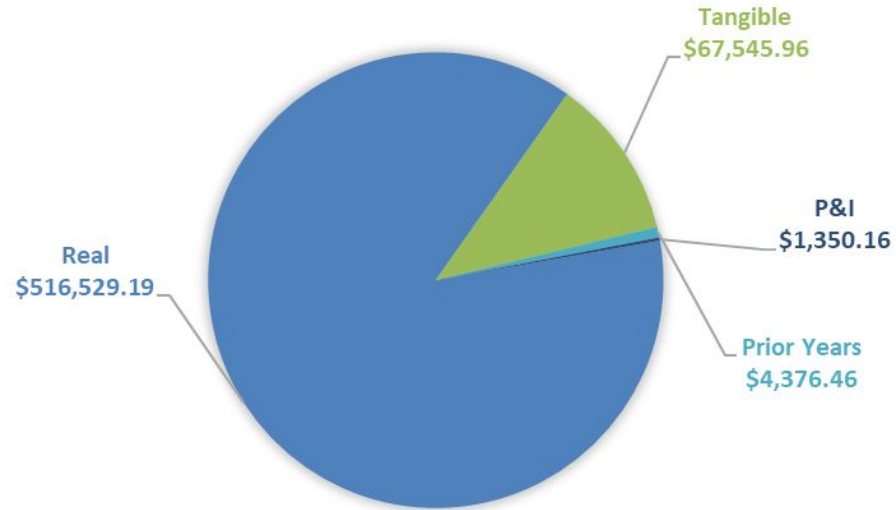

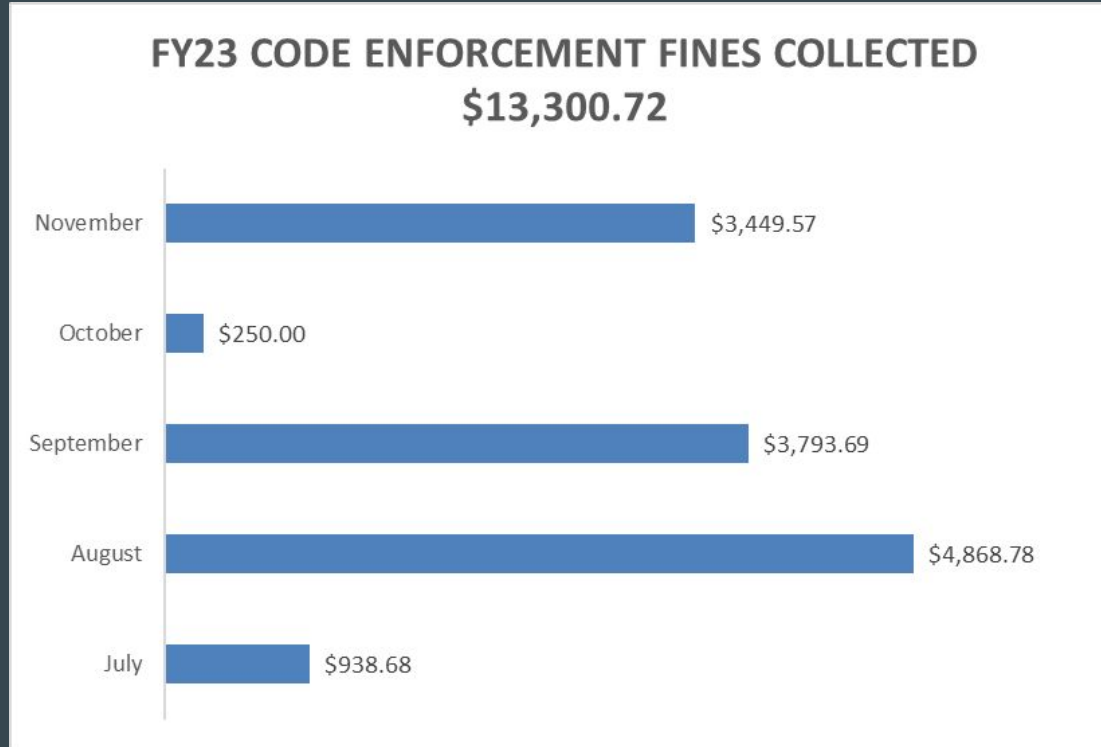

NOVEMBER PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION \$589,801.77



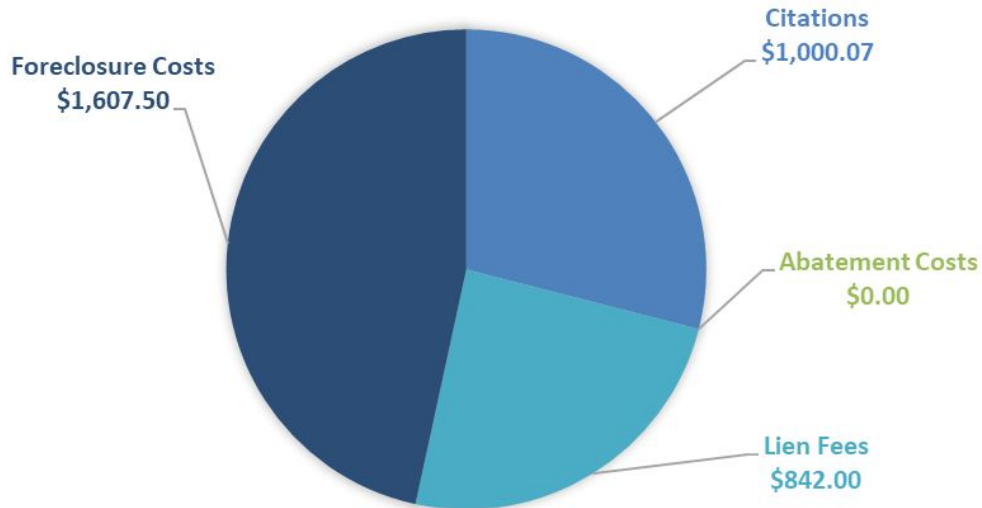
CODE ENFORCEMENT FINES COLLECTED



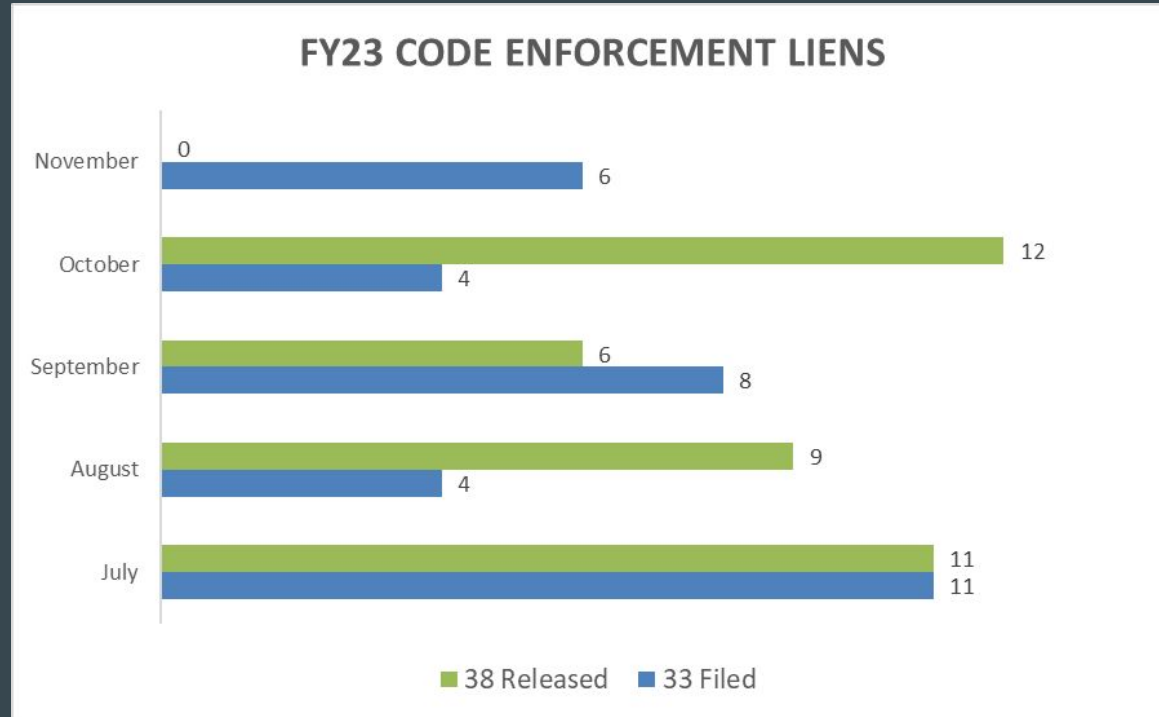

PASSPORT FEES COLLECTED

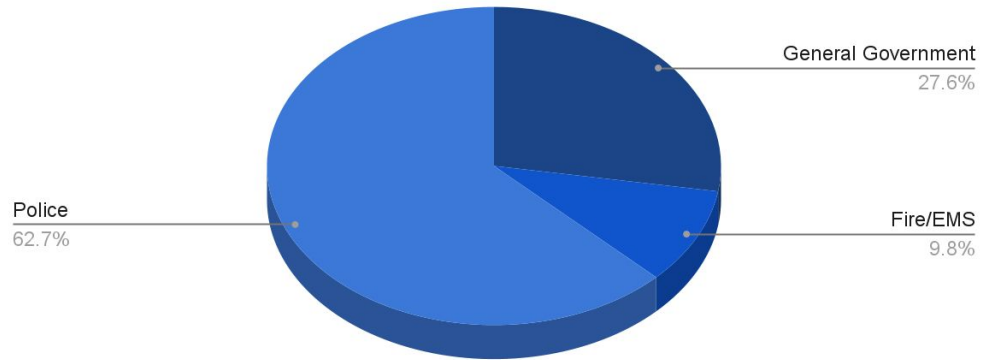

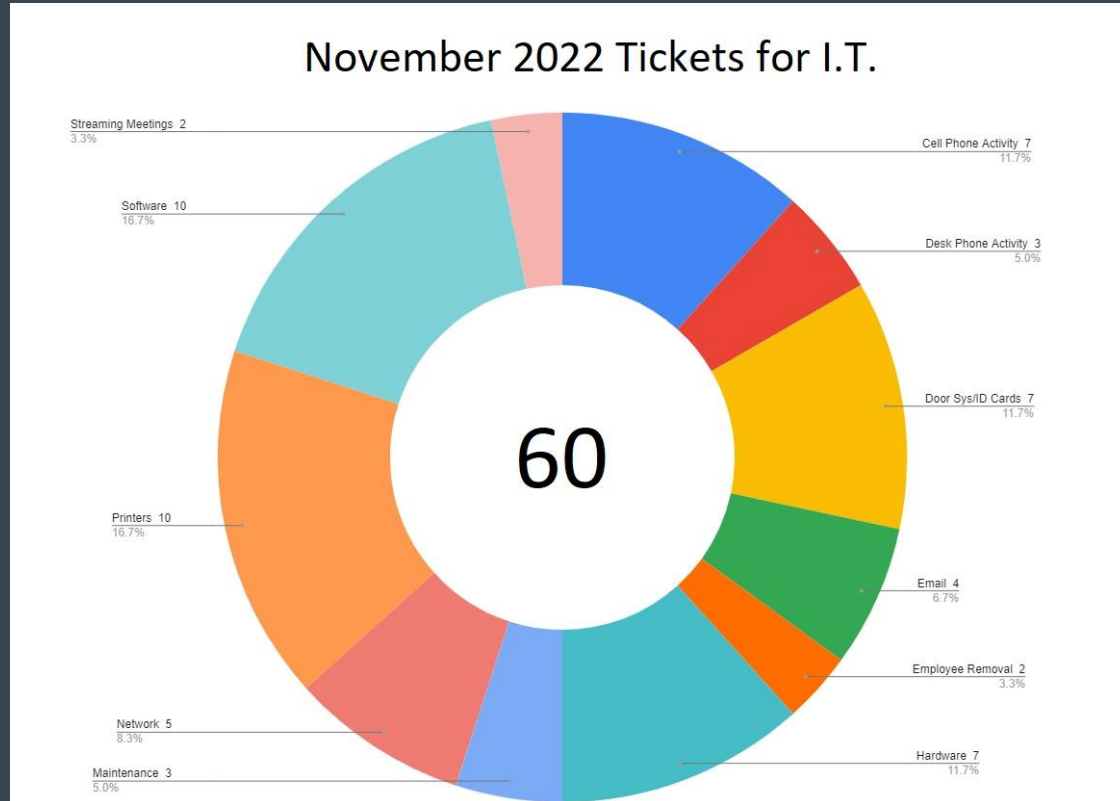
