PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT



PROGRAMS

Weather Warriors

The Weather Warriors were called into action for 2 weather events in January. The first event was sort of a surprise, the area received more snow than what they were calling for. For this event, the crews utilized **109 tons** of bulk salt at a cost of **\$9,569.11** and **106 man hours** spread over 2 shifts to combat the beast. The second event was a flop, the area did not get near what they were calling for so the crews were only out for a short period. The crews utilized **45 tons** of bulk salt at a cost of **\$3,950.55** and **48 man hours** for this event.

Street Light Assessment

The PW's department conducted its quarterly street light check. The quarterly street light check yielded **13** lights that needed attention. **9** of these lights were reported to Duke Energy and the other **4** were reported to Owen Electric to have repaired.

2022 Trash Collection

One of PW's main jobs is to pick up trash in the city parks, highway cans and all the city's right of ways keeping Erlanger the cleanest city in the area. PW's crews utilized **804 man hours** picking up **1,232 bags** of trash (4.7 bags a day) while driving **3,680 miles** throughout the city.

Christmas Tree Recycling

The annual Christmas Tree recycling program ran from December 26th through January 10th, 2023. Kenton County Public Works mulched the trees on the 10th and dispersed the mulch among County Parks and walkways. There were **53 trees** dropped off and mulched this season.



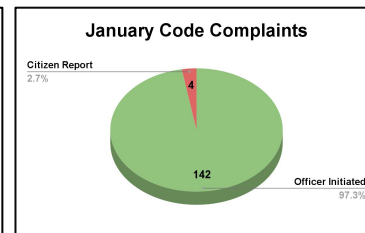
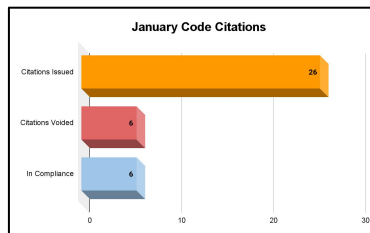
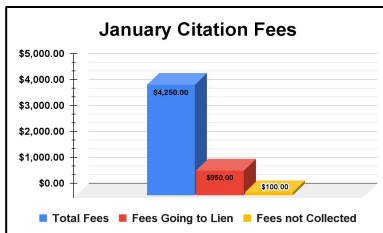

Foreclosures

A foreclosure is the legal process where your mortgage company obtains ownership of your home (i.e., repossess the property). A foreclosure occurs when the homeowner has failed to make payments and has defaulted or violated the terms of their mortgage loan. **When it is determined that a borrower is in default on a loan, the lender files a foreclosure suit with the circuit court.** Typically, the homeowner does not respond to the filing, so the court issues a default judgment for the lender.

Asphalt Paving Projects

Michels Construction has sold their business to Eaton Asphalt Paving, The City is working with Michels Construction and Eaton Asphalt on the reassignment of the contract for Jacqueline, Kimberly, Debbie and Mitten Drives project. The contract bid amount will remain at the same price just a different contractor. Eaton Asphalt did bid on this project when it was let out to bid.

The Hillcrest Drive Storm Sewer / Pavement Overlay project is out to bid and is due by February 7th, 2023 at 10:00 am. This project is a 50/50 cost share with Sanitation District #1 on the storm sewer portion which will save the city \$67,580.00.

The Cahill Commons Park improvement project will go out to bid on February 7th, 2023 and bids will be due by 10:00 am on February 21st, 2023.
