### PROGRAMS

#### Erlanger Salutes

The Erlanger Salutes Banner Program was created for the community to recognize and honor individuals on active duty, living, retired, and deceased service personnel by displaying the honoree's photo, name, rank and armed service branch on a banner to be flown from utility poles throughout the City of Erlanger. All banners are displayed with an American flag. Banners will be displayed on Commonwealth Avenue, from Baker Street to Dixie Highway, and on Dixie Highway within Erlanger city limits. When this program started four years ago, we had 13 honorees. This year, team members hung over 100 banners.

#### Mowing

The Public Works team members have been busy mowing the City's parks and right of ways. A crew of 4 team members are scheduled to cut all the parks and right of ways every week. PW crews have worked **543** man hours to keep our parks and streets looking exceptional.

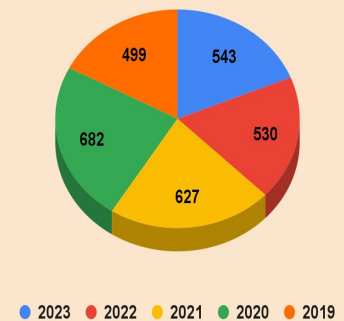
#### Mulching

The PW's Department annually has all beds and tree rings mulched prior to Memorial Day. The department does a majority of the mulching in house and utilizes contractors to mulch six locations throughout the City. This year NK Lawn Pros received the bid for the contracted mulching. All mulching has been completed for this year.

### CAPITAL PROJECTS

#### New Public Works Facilities

The new Public Works Facility is underway. A groundbreaking ceremony was held on April 7th. Grade work and tree removal started on April 10th.

#### Concrete Street Reconstruction Project

TMS Construction began the street replacement project on Crescent Ave. the first of may. The street has been completed and they poured the last piece of sidewalk on 5/24/2023 and they will finish up in the next couple of weeks tying in the new work with the parking lot to Silverlake Park with new asphalt and curbs.

Jefferson Contracting has resumed the Sigma Drive, Kappa Court and Theta Court project at the beginning of May. Theta Ct is all that is left on this project and it is 75% complete with one more street pour needed and a few driveways, aprons and sidewalks left to complete. They will be wrapped up by the middle of June.

Eaton Asphalt has resumed work as of 3/21/2023 on the Jacqueline Drive, Kimberly Drive, Mitten Drive and Debbie Lane project. They are currently on Jacqueline Drive replacing sidewalks and aprons and have completed the area from Concord to about halfway on Jacqueline. In the next few weeks, they will start the milling of old asphalt and curbs and replace with new square curbs and asphalt on the section they have completed all the sidewalk / apron work on.

#### Capital Park Improvements

The Cahill Commons Park Phase 1 improvement project is wrapping up. The new sidewalk is complete, the boulder seat wall is complete and the pull off on Rainbow Terrace is complete. Finish work, landscaping and the new fence will be installed in the next few weeks.

#### Railroad Underpass Painting Project

The Railroad Underpass painting project is moving forward with the Right of Entry permit approved and the Railroad Protection application has been submitted for approval. A pre construction meeting is anticipated for the first of May with the project to begin right after.

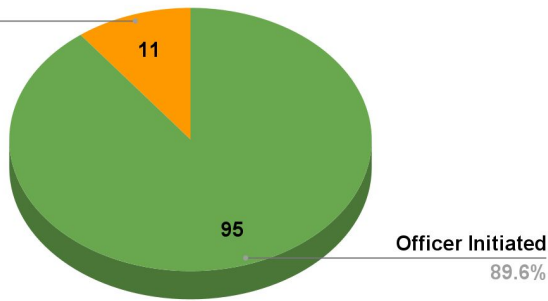
### INOPERATIVE VEHICLES

Inoperative Vehicle by definition means any vehicle which cannot be legally operated on the street because of lack of registration, lack of engine, transmission, wheels, windshield or any other part or equipment necessary to operate on public streets and/or highways. The City of Erlanger's ordinance describes an inoperative vehicle as: A motor vehicle that is either: (1) Wrecked or otherwise in a state of disrepair or disassembly; (2) Mechanically inoperable; or (3) Legally inoperable on public streets and highways. The codes department had 4 complaints of inoperative vehicles this month.

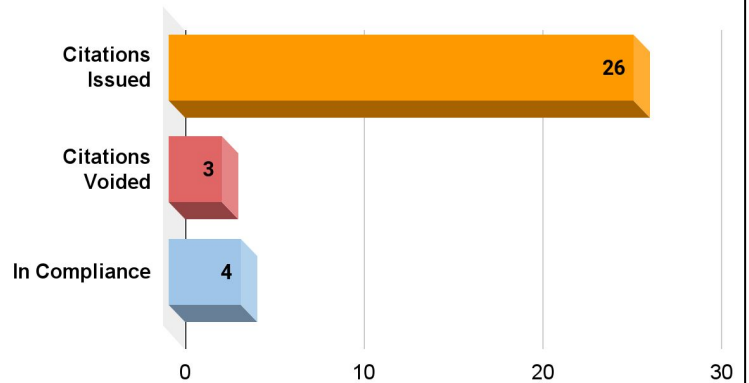


### May Code Complaints

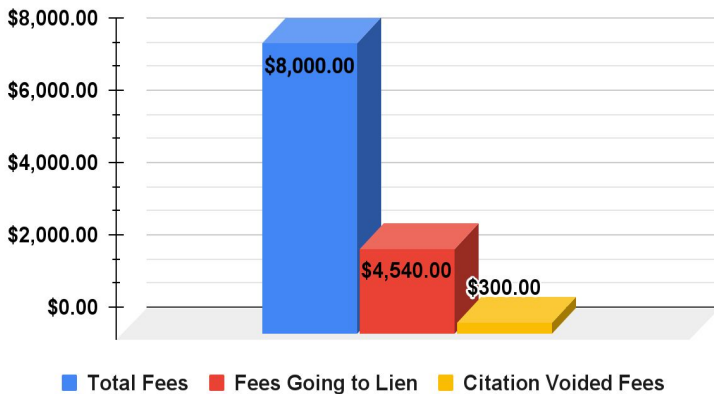
