CAUCUS DISCUSSIONS

Amended Sidewalk Agreement - Director of Public Works Kevin Quinn

- > Discussion
 - 1. The original agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet was signed in January 2022 for the Brightleaf Blvd. and Narrows Road sidewalk construction.
 - 2. The Transportation Cabinet requested an amendment to the agreement due to the increase in material costs.
 - 3. The City's increase would be an additional \$2,439 for a total of \$5,000.
- > Action Requested
 - 1. A resolution (allowing the Mayor to sign the amended agreement) to be read at the July 11, 2023 council meeting.

Gary Meyer Emergency Fund - Councilwoman Rebecca Reckers

- ➤ Discussion
 - 1. Conversation ensued on whether this ordinance was required, if there should be a second reading, or if City Council should work with staff to review, amend the strategic plan, and update the ordinance for another first reading.
- Action Requested
 - 1. Mr. Hermes recommended not having a second reading of this ordinance.

Meal Policy - City Administrator Peter Glenn

- ➤ Discussion
 - 1. He worked with Ms. Kramer and John Chamberlin to create the framework for a business meal policy.
 - 2. Each department would have \$2000 placed in their Retention and Recruitment budget specifically for this policy.
- > Action Requested
 - 1. Mr. Glenn to proceed with this policy.

FY25 Budget Schedule - City Administrator Peter Glenn

- ➤ Discussion
 - 1. He worked with Ms. Kramer to develop a timeline to address the budget process needs.
- > Action Requested
 - 1. Ms. Reckers requested that the dates for the Budget Bootcamp and the Ad Hoc Budget Committee meetings be changed.
 - 2. Mr. Glenn will update the budget timeline to reflect Ms. Recker's request.
