PROGRAMS

Street Sweeping

The Public Works Department is responsible for sweeping all City maintained streets along with various State Routes four (4) times annually. Street sweeping plays a critical role in keeping Erlanger's streets, air and water clean. A clean street keeps storm drains clear of debris, helps prevent localized street flooding due to clogged catch basins, and prevents pollutants from reaching the waterways. Street sweeping works best when the sweepers are able to sweep from curb-to curb. Vehicles or any items in the street prevent the sweeper from hugging the curb and performing the most effective sweeping possible.

Mowing

The Public Works team members have been busy mowing the City's parks and right of ways. A crew of 4 team members are scheduled to cut all the parks and right of ways every week. PW crews have worked **440** man hours to keep our parks and streets looking exceptional.

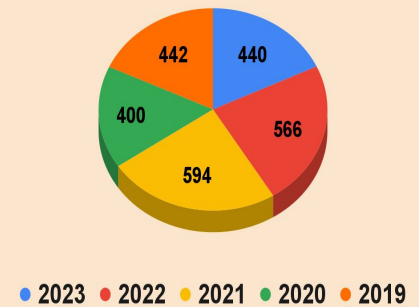
Potholes

During the second quarter of 2023, PW's crews filled **198** holes with hot mix asphalt utilizing **8.31** tons of asphalt hot mix and **74** man hours.

Choke Points

The Public Works Department has choke points throughout the city that are checked for debris before and after a substantial rainfall to prevent flooding issues. PW's refer to these areas as the "Nasty Nine". The Nasty Nine were checked **1** time utilizing **6** man hours to do so.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

New Public Works Facilities

The new Public Works Facility is coming out of the ground, the retaining wall between the admin building and the maintenance building is nearing completion and conduits for electric and communications being installed. The gravel base for the drive and parking area will began the week of July 3rd weather permitting.

Concrete Street Reconstruction Projects

TMS Construction has finished the Crescent Ave at Kenton Lands project.

Jefferson Contracting has finished the project that included Sigma Dr, Kappa Ct and Theta Ct.

Eaton Asphalt is continuing on with the Jacqueline Dr, Kimberly Dr, Mitten Dr and Debbie Ln project which will go into the next fiscal year. The project is still on Jacqueline Dr which is about 50 percent finished. There are crews replacing sidewalk and driveway aprons and crews doing full depth street repairs as well as milling the old blacktop. New curbs will be poured the week of 6/26 with a new layer of blacktop to follow.

The City will be accepting bids on July 12th for a street overlay project and a street reconstruction project. Crestside Court, Spire Circle and Summitridge Lane will be milled and an asphalt overlay applied while Circlewood Drive will be a concrete reconstruction from Ridgewood Drive to Heartwood Lane.

Capital Park Improvements

The Cahill Commons Park Phase 1 improvement project has been completed with Phase 2 set to begin this summer.

Railroad Underpass Painting Project

The Public Works department has been in contact with Baynum Painting and will be receiving the Railroad Protective Liability Insurance to enable us to set a preconstruction meeting and get rolling with this project.
