


Programs:

- Lt. Klare hosted the 71st Annual Southern Police Institute Conference. The theme of the conference was Recruitment and Retention. We welcomed law enforcement leadership from 22 states.

Training:

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol responded to a call for fraudulent prescriptions. Investigation lead to a combined effort with the NKY Drug Strike Force and several arrests were made and numerous fraudulent prescriptions seized
