



Programs / News:

- Interviews for the Police Social Worker Position were conducted and a selection was made. Maryann Moore will begin work with the Police Department as the Social Worker in early September.
- Erlanger Officers participated in the Erlanger Elsmere Schools Block Party
- Officer Martin was recognized this month by the Kentucky Office Of Highway Safety for the Occupant Protection Award
- The Kentucky League of Cities completed a review of police policy and procedures. This “risk management review done every three years. The audit looks at policy, training records, best practices, safety protocols and contains a four page checklist of specific insurance related compliance. The Auditor’s report should arrive sometime in September, preliminary we expect to do very well.

Training:

- Officer Allgeier completed phase 1 of the Criminalistics Academy at DOCJT
- Police department conducted firearms range qualifications this month
- Lt. Scroggin hosted an “Bike Officer” course. Officer Ryle completed this course and will join the Erlanger Bike Patrol Team

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Investigations ended August with 25 new cases which is the highest month seen in 5 years. Examples of those cases include; Robbery, Sexual Assaults, Assault 1st (stabbing), Cabinet for Families and Children cases (DDP 115), and Felony Thefts.
- Erlanger Detectives are working a Robbery case. The Crime Scene Team responded to robbery that occurred, they processed the scene and collected evidence.
- Erlanger Officers assisted NKY SWAT team and Independence Police Department in a homicide investigation. 2 Arrests were made in the case within 24 hrs.
