- Aerosol cans
 - Antifreeze
- Batteries (all types)
- Corrosives/Flammables (fuel, kerosene, etc.)
- Electronics (computers, monitors, keyboards, printers, cell phones, etc.)

- Ink/Toner cartridges
 - Light bulbs
 - Oil/Fluids
 - Paint (10 can limit)
 - Pesticides
 - Tanks/Cylinders
- Televisions (limit of two per vehicle)

COLLECTION DETAILS AND RESTRICTIONS

We will <u>not</u> be accepting: appliances, fertilizer, mercury-containing devices, medications, tires, or paper. Visit <u>www.nkyhhw.org</u> for proper disposal methods. We reserve the right to refuse any item that you bring.

- AEROSOL CANS: All aerosol cans will be accepted.
- **ANTIFREEZE:** Antifreeze only <u>NO</u> mixtures will be accepted.
- **BATTERIES:** All batteries will be accepted, including: Alkaline, Ni Cad, Lithium, Lead Acid, and more.
- BULBS: CFL bulbs (4-foot and 8-foot tubes) will be accepted.
- **CORROSIVES/FLAMMABLES:** Fuel and kerosene will be accepted. Absolutely <u>NO</u> ammunition, gun powder, explosives, or radioactive items will be accepted.
- **ELECTRONICS:** TVs (limit of <u>TWO</u> per vehicle), PCs, laptops, cables, cell phones, cameras, and VCRs will be accepted.
- INK/TONER CARTRIDGES: Any ink or toner cartridges that come out of a printer, copier, or fax machine will be accepted.
- OIL/FLUIDS: Used motor oil, hydraulic fluid, transmission fluid, and brake fluid will be accepted.
- **PAINT:** All types of paint will be accepted with a limit of <u>TEN</u> cans per vehicle.
- **PESTICIDES:** Pesticides will be accepted with a limit of <u>TWO</u> gallons or <u>TWO</u> pounds per vehicle.
- TANKS/CYLINDERS: Tanks and cylinders will be accepted.
