New Public Works Facilities

Mark Spaulding Construction had the revised footing and foundation plans approved through PDS and should have pricing back from bidders this week. We look for the building to be coming out of the ground during the month of October.

Concrete Street Reconstruction Project

Jefferson Contracting was awarded the project on Circlewood Dr. between Ridgewood Dr. and Heartwood Ln. doing a complete tear out of the concrete street and sidewalks and pouring new concrete. This job is slated to start on November 14th.

Street Repaying Project

Eaton Asphalt has all of the paving complete on the Jacqueline Drive, Kimberly Drive, Mitten Drive and Debbie Lane complete. There is a small amount of restoration along curb line to have this project 100%.

Riegler Blacktop has begun full depth repairs on Summitridge Ln., Crestside Ct., and Spire Cr., once the repairs have been completed milling and resurfacing will begin.

Capital Park Improvements

Beaumont Building Group has given a start date of mid October for the second Phase of Cahill Commons Park improvements.

Railroad Underpass Painting Project


