Leaf Collection Program

The 2023 Leaf Collection program came to an end on Friday, December 8th. The crews continued into the next week cleaning up leaves at the City Building and all the City Parks. As you can see on the chart, this year was the second highest number of loads collected in the 5 year span. This is an Exceptional program put together by the crew in the way they run the routes to the dumping of the leaves.

Christmas Tree Recycling

The annual Christmas Tree recycling program will run from December 26th through January 10th, 2024. The trees will then be mulched by Kenton County Public Works and will be disbursed among several county parks as bedding and for walking paths. The trees can be dropped off at the Erlanger Public Works facility on Jack Scheben Drive


Potholes

New Public Works Facilities

The new facilities are coming out of the ground. Work is steadily progressing on the new Public Works Facilities, the footings have been laid and block is being set on the maintenance building wash/storage bay along with foundation walls in the maintenance area. Footings have also been installed for the administration building.

Concrete Street Reconstruction Project

Jefferson Contracting started the project on Circlewood Drive between Ridgewood Drive and Heartwood Lane on Monday November 6th. They have completed all of the street pours with the last pour coming out of cure on Wednesday 12/20/2023. They poured the last sections of sidewalk on the same day with clean up and ground restoration to follow. They will return during the first couple of weeks in January to finish up any restoration work, move out any equipment and take down the construction signs.

Capital Park Improvements

Beaumont Building Group continues with the Phase II renovation to Cahill Commons with the installation of some of the new sidewalk section that will wrap the basketball court. Work will continue as weather permits.


Planning

Public Works Team Members have been working with the Viox & Viox Team preparing the next round of street improvement projects set to go out for bid late January.






