

MEETING MINUTES

Kevin Quinn called the meeting of the Urban Forest Commission (UFC) to order at the Erlanger Public Works building on Thursday, October 19, 2023 at 4:01 p.m.

Meeting Minutes – September Meeting

The September meeting minutes were approved by Jason James and Todd Herrmann.

Tree Planting Initiative

- Meg Casper, Johnna, and Todd met outside this meeting to review applications from other cities.
- Ideal for residents to pay for the tree; the City would install it and mulch; supply a gator bag.
- Kevin raised the idea to the Mayor; need to research if the City Employees can plant the tree on the resident's property.
- Residents would fill out an application for approval.
- Need to design the tree application and will bring the best of all together for our application
- Small, medium, large tree based on zone of the city – evaluate if this is needed
- Call before we dig
- Process could be for the UFC to review and approve all applications
- Start with 15 trees
- Aiming to launch the program in Fall 2024
- Deadline to apply for a tree would be end of August 2024
- Next steps: Develop the program framework and draft application; goal is to have it ready in January to present to the Mayor.

UFC Strategy Discussion

- Recommendation: Sharpen our area of focus on urban forestry activities
- Suggested activities for the Growth Award could spur ideas for our roadmap (and we could apply for this award in 2024):
- We will look at these items as a way to build a 2024 roadmap for our commission (5 year plan)
- Starting to look at landscape ordinances as part of the zoning requirements, new developments for example
- Important to get the businesses and developments on board
- Ideally when a tree dies, one is replaced or planted somewhere else

Arbor Day

- We will get 10 free sapling trees from Arbor Day Foundation.
- Targeting October 2024.
- Would be good to market/promote the Tree Planting initiative at this event
- Summer Sendoff promotion opportunity?


Kenton Lands Project


- Targeting spring for wildflowers/butterfly habitat


