

Programs / News:

- Officer Eagler has joined the Tri-State Peer Support as a member of the board
- Officer Eagler and PSW Moore continue to work on Peer support programs and implementation.
- The command staff met and prepared the 24-25 Budget forms
- 2nd of 3 Highschool interns completed this month. We have incorporated Dispatch, the Prosecutor's Office, and the Detention Center into the internship.
- We are planning a new hiring test and coordinating with applicants. We have several Military to Law Enforcement candidates who are traveling in to test with our agency.

Training:

- Department firearms qualifications were completed this month with new "red dot" sights on our duty pistols. These proved to be a great asset to officers during qualifications.
- Critical incident debriefing took place this month for officers involved in the investigation of a fatal collision on the interstate.
- Several policies were reviewed for update this month.

Investigations/Case Highlights:

• Detectives also testified in Hamilton County, Ohio Common Pleas Court in a homicide case. Defendant Jack Grubbs was charged with Murder, Felonious Assault, and, Involuntary Manslaughter. The firearm involved in the case was found in Erlanger. Detective Holmstrom had taken the firearm to the NIBIN Center in Cincinnati, Ohio for testing. It was determined that the firearm was connected to the case mentioned above. The defendant would be found guilty of those charges.
