


Programs / News:

- We concluded a hiring process early this month and have hired a new recruit, Emily Taylor. Ofc. Taylor was sworn in on May 28th and will be attending the academy in August.
- Lt. Atchley organized a grill out at Miles Elementary for Teacher appreciation.
- We concluded the spring high school interns this month with a field trip to DOCJT. We received great feedback and have expressed interest from an additional school for next spring.
- We have begun work with a college intern, a senior from Thomas More. He will be with us a couple of days a week throughout the summer and is interested in pursuing law enforcement upon graduation.
- We participated in the annual Memorial Day parade and ceremony
- We participated in the Police Officer's Memorial Ceremony held annually in Covington

Training:

- Detective Holmstrom graduated from the Criminalistic I (5 week) training course.
- Officer Plunkett successfully completed his Field Training and is working on his own.
- Officer Eagler and PSW Moore attended the Officer Wellness Symposium to continue building resources for officer mental wellness

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Officers / Detectives worked a stabbing investigation that was reported hours after the incident. Suspect has been interviewed and charged
- Ofc Hartke/ K9 Keno and Ofc. Lonaker assisted Kenton County Police in locating a subject that fled in the woods from a domestic dispute with Assault 1st charges. He was taken into custody without incident.
- Thefts of vehicles have been an ongoing focus this month. Our officers have arrested several juveniles in connection to the thefts and several vehicles have been recovered both inside and outside of the city. The crime scene team has processed several recovered stolen vehicles for evidence this month.
- Officers arrested a female after she brandished a gun at a fight on Greenfield
- Patrol made numerous drug arrests from traffic stops, including a trafficking case with a seizure of \$18,000
