Passport Requirements

Evidence of US Citizenship - One of the following:

- Certified Birth Certificate from state, city or county with a raised seal (hospital certificates are not acceptable)
- Previously issued undamaged US Passport (minors must submit birth certificate in addition to passport)
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Birth
- Naturalization Certificate or Certificate of Citizenship

Identification - Driver's license, State ID, Military ID, Passport (children need parents' ID)

OUT OF STATE APPLICANTS must present a second ID

i.e., employment ID, voter registration card, student ID, social security card, credit card

Photo - See passport application for specifications. Services offered at Walgreens, CVS, FedEx Office, Sam's, etc.

Application - Please have your application filled out ahead of time **IN BLACK INK**

Application Fee - Payable to US Dept. of State - Check or Money Order Only
