


Programs / News:

- The Police department assisted in organizing several partners and participated in the City's Annual Touch a Truck Event. We had the Kenton County Detention Center, KY Office of Highway Safety Roll Over truck, NKY SWAT, our K9s, Drone Team, Detectives and Crime Scene Team, and Police Social Services to participate.
- We would like to welcome Officer Tori Monson. She was sworn in on June 24th. She will complete some field training before attending the academy this fall.
- Detective Brian Guilfoyle returned from a year (+) deployment in the Middle East. We are happy to welcome him back and to have his safe return.
- The Police Department is planning and announced several upcoming community events on social media over the next couple of months

Training:

- Det. Loos is currently training Active Shooter / Rapid Response training with Erlanger and Elsmere Police Departments and Erlanger/Elsmere School personnel.
- Two patrol officers were selected to attend and become "Peer Support" officers
- Recruit officers Taylor and Monson are working several areas of training prior to Academy this fall
- College Intern Stuckey has had the opportunity to participate in some of the recruit training as well.

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol made several sizable drug arrests and seizures from self-initiated traffic stop investigations including: fentanyl, meth, Vicodin, and suboxone.
- Patrol assisted at the scene in the fatal collision in Crescent Springs on I75 involving a small child
- Criminal Investigations went to preliminary court on an Assault 2nd / Burglary case which will go before the Grand Jury.
- Criminal Investigations are also working several new child sexual abuse cases this month.
