
## ERLANGER POLICE

**Programs / News:** 

- We would like to welcome Officer Sawyer Smith to the police Department. Ofc. Smith is the first M-2-LE program officer to be hired. This is a special program that works with the branches of the military to bridge military separation into a career in law enforcement. Ofc. Smith served with the United States Marines. He will complete a portion of his training while finishing active duty military and be officially hired by Erlanger in late August.
- Our intern from Thomas More has nearly completed his 90 hours and will be finishing up early next month. He plans on applying for a police officer position next year.
- The Drone Team attended Depot Days for the City Parks program and conducted demonstrations
- Fill a Cruiser Drive was done at Family Dollar and Dollar General (CaveRun) for Erlanger Elsmere School Supplies for the family resource centers.

## **Training:**

- High risk S.T.O.P.S (felony traffic stops) training was conducted this month
- New hired officers and our intern were trained and certified by Sgt. Hines this month in CPR
- Firearms qualifications were completed this month
- New recruit officers Taylor, Monson, and Smith have begun FTO training and online academy
- Officer Ryle is currently in training to become one of Kentucky's first Police Phlebotomist for DUI investigation blood draws. The training is sponsored and fully funded by the Kentucky Office of Highway Safety.
