


Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol responded to an active assault in progress on Ridgewood Drive that became a Murder Investigation. The suspect was taken into custody on scene. The Criminal Investigative Division responded and took over the investigation. Wyatt Testerman was been charged with Murder. The victim was Testerman's grandmother.
- Criminal Investigation Division is now working an additional investigation stemming from an assault from several months ago and the victim recently died from his injuries.
- Officers worked a vehicle vs train collision. The operator was uninjured, but intoxicated and drove onto the railroad tracks. The operator of the vehicle was arrested.
- Officers investigated a potential snake reported in the area of Riggs and Division. The department worked with snake experts and placed trail cameras, but the snake was never confirmed.
