


Programs / News:

- Officers participated in the annual COPS n Kids event.
- Sergeant Justin Auton graduated from the 10 week leadership training FBINA
- Officer Sawyer Smith graduated from the Basic Police Academy at DOCJT
- Officer Brad Diel was sworn on as a lateral officer earlier this month. He comes to us from Kansas with 15 years of law enforcement experience.
- Lt. Klare was requested by the KY Transportation Cabinet and KY Office of Highway Safety to speak at their press conference in Frankfort for the "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Campaign"
- PSW Moore worked with Independence PD to help build and hire for their new PSW program

Training:

- Det. Loos finalized the annual fitness test, impact weapon recertification, and ECW (Taser) recertification for the entire department.
- Officers Emily Taylor and Tori Monson are both completing the in person Basic Academy at DOCJT
- Officers Eagler and Ernst successfully destroyed 200 items of disposed evidence from a court ordered destruction. They continue to go a great job of keeping our police inventory updated and in order.

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol worked with School Resource Officers to identify and charge 4 juveniles in the repeated Criminal Mischief to our City Parks. CDW and prosecutors will seek restitution for the damages.
- Patrol investigated a hit and run collision this month with two pedestrians who were struck. Officers and Dispatch broadcasted the description which led to Taylor Mill Police locating the suspect on I275 approaching Wilder. The suspect was found to be intoxicated, a prior convicted felon, and in possession of an AR style weapon. The teamwork and investigation led to the arrest and multiple charges against the suspect.
