Leaf Collection Program

Christmas Tree Recycling


The annual Christmas Tree recycling program will run from December 26th through January 13th, 2025. The trees will then be mulched by Kenton County Public Works and will be disbursed among several county parks as bedding and for walking paths. New Public Works Facilities

The old Public Works Facility is slowly being transferred to the new facility. All of the admin/office supplies have been moved with the admin team working from the new facility permanently. The operational side of the department is a slow move as you could expect with all of the logistics the department has for all of its many tasks. Street Reconstruction Projects

Yager Court is on tap for a full replacement with sidewalks and aprons but is on hold until the weather becomes more favorable towards early spring.

Kentaboo Avenue and Virginia Avenue went out to bid. The bids were opened in December with Jefferson Contracting being awarded the contract. This project is expected to start in early spring.

Sidewalk Replacement Program

The sidewalk program is on winter break. The work will continue when the weather breaks in early spring and the contractor will continue in the Cherry Hill subdivision.

Park Projects




