- Training officer Eagler is on the board for a newly established Kentucky Evidence Managers Association

Training:

- Firearms qualification was conducted this month with the police department. Focus was on off duty weapons and patrol rifle.

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol and Detectives worked in collaboration to investigate and make an arrest in a reported Rape and Strangulation case. The victim was able to be assisted for short term by the E-Angel program.
- Patrol through a self-initiated traffic stop located a large amount of marijuana and cocaine along with a stolen firearm.
- Officers responded to a call of juveniles breaking into vehicles in the area of Hulbert and side streets. Officers located juveniles and took them into custody.
- During Traffic Grant overtime, patrol made a traffic stop for occupant protection/ seat belt violation. During the investigation, 28 bindles of cocaine were located in the vehicle. The suspect was arrested for trafficking in Cocaine.
