

## **ERLANGER POLICE**



# June 2025 MONTHLY REPORT





#### Programs / News:

- Officers and Staff participated in the City Night Out event at the Train Depot
- Erlanger Police assisted in organizing this year's Touch a Truck Event. There was a great turn out.
   Detective's, K9, Police Social Worker, Crime Scene Team, Bike patrol all came. Additionally, we were able to help coordinate SWAT and the Kenton County Detention Center.
- PSW Moore in collaboration with "Joe Burrow Foundation" and "Food for the Soul" hosted a community fresh produce market. We were able to serve 67 families in the community with deeply discounted fresh produce.
- Our officers stopped and surprise a child for her birthday in this city this month. The mom had requested a "drive by parade". Our officers gathered some small gifts and stopped for a surprise visit!

#### Training:

- Firearms training was conducted this month for the police department.
- KLEC came to the PD and certified a team of officers to be able to administer the POPS physical fitness testing for new hire officers.
- Officers Centers is attending Enhanced Handgun performance course this month at DOCJT
- Recruits Pearson and Racke are doing well at DOCJT in Basic Training
- Det Jansen attended a Forensic Mapping Course at DOCJT this month

### Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol and Detectives worked on a large investigation with multiple individuals on a stabbing case on Crescent Ave. All parties were identified and the case is awaiting charges with the Commonwealth Attorney's Office
- Officers responded to the report of a subject trying to cash a fraudulent social security check at the Post
  Office. Their investigation resulted in the arrest of two suspects and the identification of a third suspect for
  Identity Theft (numerous counts) and Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument (numerous counts). The
  same suspects are being investigated in Texas and Virginia for similar/same crimes. Officers collaborated with
  the outside State agencies to properly identify the suspects and gather further case information. The work by
  our officers generated enough investigative case information that the Postal Inspector picked up the case to
  charge the suspects federally.
