## PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT



### PROGRAMS

#### Mowing

The Public Works team members continue mowing the City's parks and right of ways. A crew of 4 team members are scheduled to cut all the parks and right of ways every week. PW crews have worked **522** man hours to keep our parks and streets looking exceptional.

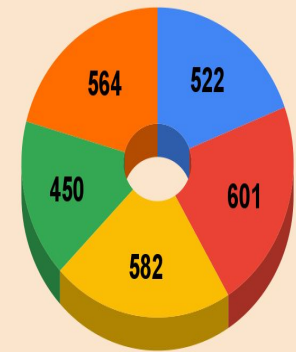
#### Choke Points

The Public Works Department has choke points throughout the city that are checked for debris before and after a substantial rainfall to prevent flooding issues. PW's refer to these areas as the "Nasty Nine". The Nasty Nine were checked **1** time utilizing **5** man hours to do so.

#### Street Sweeping

The Public Works Department is responsible for sweeping all City maintained streets along with various State Routes four (4) times annually. Street sweeping plays a critical role in keeping Erlanger's streets, air, and water clean. A clean street keeps storm drains clear of debris, helps prevent localized street flooding due to clogged catch basins, and prevents pollutants from reaching the waterways. Street sweeping works best when the sweepers are able to sweep from curb-to-curb. Vehicles or any items in the street prevent the sweeper from hugging the curb and performing the most effective sweeping possible.

### CAPITAL PROJECTS

#### Street Reconstruction Projects

The Kentaboo Avenue and Virginia Avenue project is near completion with minor blacktop work and soil restoration to be completed.

The Hallam Avenue project is complete.

The Elm Street project is complete.

The Yager Court project started in mid June with one half of the street being completed from the cul de sac out to Concord. Several of the aprons in the cul de sac have been poured back. The contractor is currently working on the second half of the cul de sac replacing the street and driveway aprons. The sidewalks will come next and finish the project.

The Narrows Road bridge replacement project is complete with new asphalt and guard rail being applied in mid to late June.

Sherbourne Drive island project is complete.

#### Sidewalk Replacement Program

The sidewalk program for FY 24/25 is complete. This project will pick back up in FY 25/26

#### Park Project

Sherbourne Park is coming to a completion. The playground is open, the shelter has had the roof completed, the water fountain is going in, and the landscaping has started. This will finish the project.

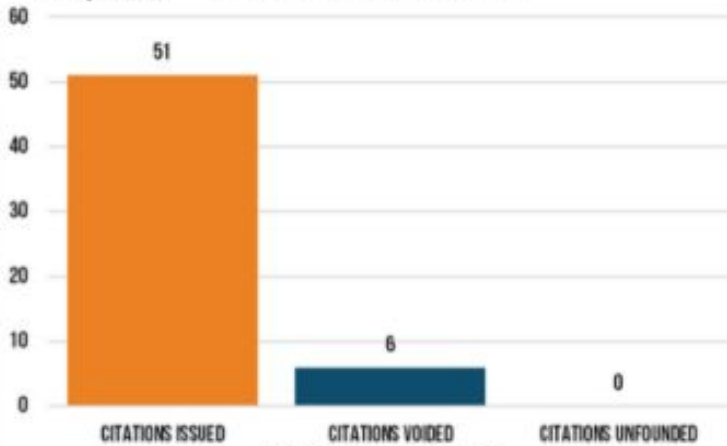

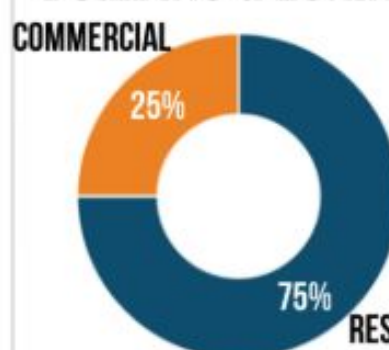
### BUILDING ONLY



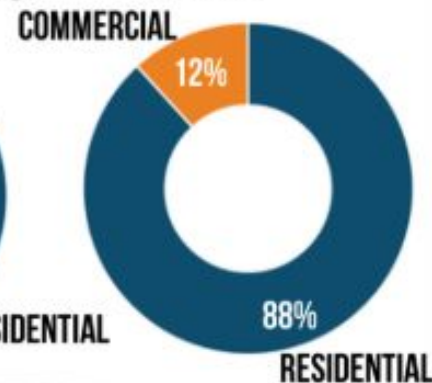
### ZONING ONLY
