CAUCUS DISCUSSIONS

HB 160 Zoning Regulations and Manufactured Housing - Andy Videkovich with PDS of Kenton Co.

- HB 160 Presentation
 1. Effective July 1, 2026
 2. City of Erlanger's zoning ordinance already allows manufactured housing, which are houses built off site and are not the same as mobile homes
 3. Home Owner Association's may have additional restrictions
- Action Requested
 1. Clarification from Mr. Videkovich on whether concrete blocks would be allowed for foundations

Small Business Task Force - Council Member Tyson Hermes

- Action Requested
 1. Mr. Hermes requested a task force meeting; Council Member Rebecca Reckers advised a meeting would be scheduled in August prior to the caucus meeting
