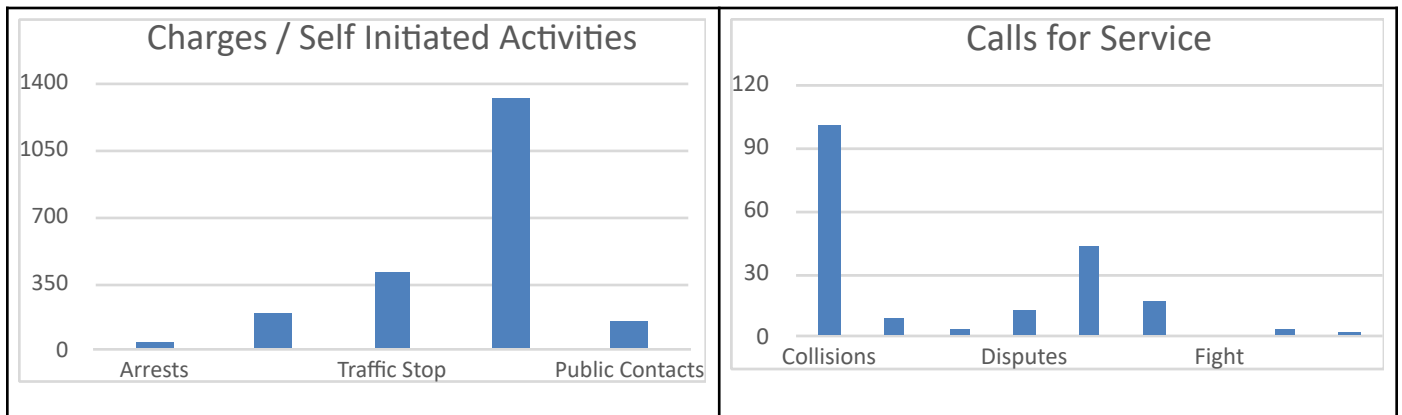

Programs / News:

Training:

- Department wide Rapid Response training

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Erlanger officers assisted Independence PD in the double murder/suicide call this month
- Erlanger officers assigned to SWAT assisted in an apprehension of an armed and barricaded subject
- Officers and K9 units located a subject they were dispatched to an attempt to locate; the subject fled into the woods upon a traffic stop and was apprehended very quickly by Erlanger K9 without injuries or further incident.
- Patrol is continuing to investigate an arson report at Deco Marche; a possible lead has been developed through cooperation with a surrounding county.
- Officers responded to an armed suicidal subject in the wood line off of Lindenwood. Officers successfully set a perimeter and negotiated with the subject, talking him out of the woods unharmed and transported him for mental health care.
- The Detectives office signed charges this month after a lengthy investigation into a road rage shooting on Donaldson in April of this year. The suspect has been identified and a warrant has been obtained.
