CAUCUS DISCUSSIONS

Dolwick Text and Map Amendment - City Administrator Mark Collier

- ➤ Discussion
 - 1. The map amendment was requested by Corporex on behalf of Key Property Development LLC, who applied to the Kenton County Planning Commission (KCPC).
 - 2. The City of Erlanger requested a text amendment and applied to KCPC to remove the requirement of detached garages.
 - 3. KCPC held a public hearing for the text and map amendment applications; Mr. Gatlin attended; KCPC recommended both the text and map amendments.
 - 4. Mr. Gatlin advised that the City Council could discuss the amendment, but in order for further discussion by the public, a public hearing would need to be held.
- > Action Requested
 - 1. The first reading of ordinances approving the text and map amendments to be held on November 4, 2025.

HB 160 Manufactured Homes Regulations - Patrick Denbow, Planning Development Services (PDS)

- > Discussion
 - 1. HB 160 prohibits local governments from adopting or enforcing zoning regulations that treat manufactured homes differently from single-family homes.
 - 2. Recommended changing the current zoning ordinance to reflect the new law; PDS would submit the amended ordinance for City Council to review and adopt.
- > Action Requested
 - 1. The first reading of an ordinance approving the amended zoning ordinance to be held once it is submitted by PDS.
