Training:

Investigations/Case Highlights:

- Patrol and PSW Moore assisted the Drug Strike Force in a search warrant investigation that resulted in 4 subjects arrested for drug trafficking and placement for a 3 yo that was taken from the home.
- Patrol assisted Boone County is serving arrest warrants for Robbery that occurred in Boone County.
- Officers Monson and Ellison arrived quickly in response to an unconscious unresponsive subject, and immediately began assisting in CPR, regained a pulse and breathing before transport
- Police and Fire worked collaboratively for a gas leak at Crescent Ridge Academy. Student were evacuated and reunited with their families efficiently and timely.
- A second call for an unconscious unresponsive subject was received and officers responded
- Sgt Hines’ shift, including: Officers Martin, Hartke, Lyle, Diel, and Racke responded to an unresponsive unconscious subject and did CPR until EMS could arrive. A pulse and breathing were regained before transport to St. E
- Several Drug recognition Evaluations and Police Phlebotomy Blood draws were completed this month both in Erlanger and assisting other agencies
- The K9 teams conducted several searches in and out of the city this month. 2 separate searches were conducted for a report of a shooting near Eagle Creek that was later determined to be self-inflicted to the foot.
