**Investigations/Case Highlights:**

- Patrol and SRO quickly investigated a possible threat of a firearm being brought to schools. It was determined to be information that was exaggerated and was not a credible threat. The response by both patrol and SROs were quick and well planned
- Patrol assisted in the execution of a search warrant with the NKY Drug Strike Force which resulted in multiple arrests.
- Patrol apprehended a felon in possession of a firearm, which was picked up by the ATF and is now being charged federally.
- Patrol located and assisted in the apprehension in Erlanger of a burglary suspect from Ft. Thomas
- Patrol and Detectives responded to a report of a shooting on Riggs Ave early this month. It was a great collaboration between patrol and detectives and the scene was secured and parties detained effectively. The continued investigation by Detectives lead to additional crimes and charges related to Unlawful Transaction with a minor and various pornography related charges.
